Sir,

I do myself the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 12th Ult^o: & to enclose the copy of a letter from Mr. Blair containing two communications which he had received from Mr. Francis Keate dated respectively 29th May & 14th June. The former enquiring in what way he is to be compensated for the loss of one horse & the service of another purchased by the Mounted Police, & the latter furnishing the particulars of his demand amounting to thirty two pounds ten shillings.

In answer I am directed to inform you that under all the circumstances of the case a compensation maybe granted to Mr. Keate of thirty five pounds which is the full price at which horses for the Mounted Police can now be obtained.

Nevertheless I am to add could not feel justified in authorizing compensation for the use of the horse which has been returned to Mr. Keate though his negligence has in awarding full compensation for the horse that has been lost given some consideration to the fact of the Police having had the service of the other

Required, - but a man ^{in attendance on the sick} been sent down from the Station, the expense would be double & more for his keep, - I cannot see why the Bill is refused payment, - for in the event of the Govt not keeping an Hospital - but there is a Public one here, the man must be sent to it, as in all other cases, and the Govt charged with the full expense, Doctor Clarke could not be expected to take up 65 miles to attend on man.
