A HARD CASE.

An elderly man named Robert Colquhoun was summoned at the South Melbourne court on Saturday for the recovery of £10 10s 3d, being arrears for the support of his daughter, Jane Colquhoun, in the Industrial School. Mr. Gausson informed the bench that the particulars of the case were outrageous. It was purely out of charity that he appeared for Colquhoun. The Bench, after learning the circumstances of the case, would agree with him that it was a pity that industrial schools were allowed to exist. In 1875 a daughter of Colquhoun was committed to the Industrial School for larceny. She was then quite a girl, and her father, the defendant, was ordered to pay 5s. per week for her support. At the expiration of the term a brother and a sister petitioned the authorities for her release. They desired that she should come home, but for some unexplained reason the authorities refused to allow her to do so. She was sent out to service, and whilst in her situation became a mother. The child was born in the Lying-in Hospital, and the father escaped his just punishment. When the school authorities learned that she had been the mother of a child, they sent word to her brother and sister to come and take her home, and do what they wished with her. They did so, and she was now at service up country. About three years ago the defendant met with a tramway accident, by which his leg was broken, and he had been unable to earn wages since. The Bench recognised the hardship of the case, and ordered the imprisonment of the old man until the rising of the Court.
