 of Westarlee St Andrews aforesaid died on the twenty eighth day
 of February One thousand nine hundred and twenty two at 46
 Fellows Road Hampstead in the said County of London intestate
 a single woman **And whereas** I am the Administrator of
 the Estate of the said Henrietta Mary Wilson acting under Letters
 of Administration granted by the Principal Probate Registry of
 the High Court of Justice in England on the seventeenth day
 of May One thousand nine hundred and twenty two **And**
whereas the said Henrietta Mary Wilson at the time of her
 decease was possessed of or entitled to certain property in the
 State of Victoria **And whereas** I am desirous of appointing
 The Trustees Executors and Agency Company Limited whose registered

And I hereby declare that this Power of Attorney shall continue
