If the said Association obtains Probate it will well and truly collect and administer according to law and to the best of its knowledge and ability the property lands and hereditaments goods chattels and credits of the said deceased at the time of her death which at any time after shall come to the power or control hands or possession of the said Association as her executor or of any other person or persons for it and that it will make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the property lands and hereditaments goods chattels and credits of the said deceased which shall have come to the hands possession or knowledge of it or to the hands or possession of any other person or persons for it and the same so made will seal with its proper seal and will exhibit and deposit or cause to be exhibited and deposited the same inventory in the office of the Master-in-Equity within three calendar months next ensuing the order granting probate and further that it will make or cause to be made a true and just account of the administration of the estate which it has undertaken as to its receipts and disbursements and as to what portion is retained by it and what portion remains uncollected and the same so made will seal with its proper seal and will exhibit and deposit or cause to be exhibited and deposited the said account in the office of the Master-in-Equity within fifteen calendar months next ensuing the order granting probate.

10. That the said deceased was at the date of her death a British subject by birth.
