POLICE INTELLIGENCE.

A DASTARDLY DEED.

At the North Melbourne Court yesterday, before Dr. F. Lloyd and Messrs. J. Barwise and G. V. Blackburne, J.P.'s, William R. Gilmore was charged with "maliciously throwing a corrosive fluid" in the face of Thomas Doyle on the 24th inst. Proceedings were taken under section 29 of the Crimes Act. Doyle said that on the 23rd about midnight he met accused at a coffee-stall in Victoria-street, and when he suggested that accused go home early on the morning of the 24th the latter called out, "Take that," and threw some burning fluid over witness, causing him intense pain in the face, especially as regarded the eyes.

Constable Curran said, from a complaint Doyle made to him, he arrested Gilmore, who said nothing, and took Doyle to the Hospital. William Coleman, proprietor of the coffee-stall, deposed to seeing accused throw something in Doyle's face, which witness and a watchman subsequently found out to be the glass bottle produced. He did not see accused and Doyle quarrel. Dr. H. Stanley, of the Eye and Ear Hospital, said he had treated Doyle. He found the left eye injured and much inflamed. The eye was likely to be always weak. If Doyle had not been attended to at once he would probably have lost his sight. Mr. Wilkinson, assistant Government analyst, said he had examined the hat and coat produced. They had been sprinkled with a corrosive liquor, which he had ascertained to be spirits of salt. The Bench committed Gilmore for trial.
