FATAL STREET ASSAULT.

WOMAN WAYLAIED AND KILLED.

YOUNG SAILOR CHARGED WITH MURDER.

A revolting crime was committed at nightfall last evening in the west end of the city. A respectable elderly woman, while walking along Latrobe-street, near the corner of Spencer-street, was attacked and criminally assaulted by a man. She screamed for help, and struggled to free herself, but her assailant dashed her head several times against the ground with such violence that her skull was fractured, and she was instantly killed.

The victim, Sophia Rigg, was the wife of a driver named William Rigg, and lived at 325 Spencer-street, a few doors from the corner of Latrobe-street. She was the mother of a large family, one of her sons, Thomas Rigg, who is married, living at 34 Adderley-street. His mother had left home in order to visit him when she was waylaid and murdered.

Mrs. Rigg was at home during the early part of the evening. Her husband states that she left home at a quarter to 8 o'clock, announcing that she was "going round to see Tom." She had a chat outside her house with a neighbour, Miss Williams, and went across the road to see another neighbour named Mrs. Lawson. She then remarked that the night was chilly, and returned home for her cape, telling her husband that she would be back soon. She walked away alone, and turned into Latrobe-street, which leads into Adderley-street.

The unfortunate woman had not walked 200 yards when she met her assailant. The street, though fairly wide, has no houses on the south side, while midway on the north side is a large vacant allotment. Mrs. Rigg had just passed this space when she was attacked.

The incident must have occupied only a very few moments. A young man named Norman Elsworth, who is employed at the Mint, was riding past on his bicycle when he heard a succession of loud screams, and saw two persons—a man and a woman—struggling on the ground. The man was dashing the woman's head against the asphalted path, but ceased as two other men came running towards the spot, and lay motionless beside her.

Constable M'Loughlin arrived a moment later. He was going on duty, when, passing along Spencer-street, he saw several people running down Latrobe-street. He followed them, and found two men holding a young sailor, whom they had just succeeded in dragging off the woman's body. The woman was lying across the pavement on her back, with her clothing disarranged. The constable felt her wrist and found it pulseless. Then, striking a match, he saw that there were several wounds on the back of the head. She appeared to be lifeless. An ambulance was telephoned for, and the body was taken to the Melbourne Hospital, where life was pronounced extinct. A constable conveyed it to the Morgue.

The noise of the disturbance was heard by a number of people living in the street, and a few minutes after the occurrence a small crowd had gathered about the spot. Several among them recognised the deceased woman, and sent for her relatives. Her son arrived before the body was removed, and his grief was painful to witness. He had expected his mother earlier, and not seeing her, was walking towards her house when he was attracted by the crowd to the spot.

Two of the bystanders held their prisoner until the constable was ready to remove him to the Bourke-street west watchhouse. He was in a state of semi-intoxication, and treated the affair lightly. At the watchhouse he stated that he was a Swedish sailor, aged 20, and that his name was Emil Torsell. He had been working for some days past on an American barque, which is berthed at the docks. Having given this information, he picked up his hat and prepared to leave. He appeared surprised at being detained, and then remarked, "They can't arrest me for that. I didn't do anything."

The assistance of the detective office was sought, and Detectives Dungey, McManamy, Dalton, and Tognini arrived, and commenced making inquiries in the neighbourhood. The only statement of importance was obtained from Francis Whittaker, a storeman employed by Mr. E. P. Bevan, machinery importer. The occurrence took place outside Whittaker's house. He states that he left off work at 25 minutes to 9 o'clock, when a man named Reid helped him to remove some machinery in the store next to his house. As they were leaving the premises, a neighbour, named John Thomson, joined them, and said—"There are two sailors down the street. I think we had better watch them." They went towards the spot where Thomson pointed out two figures, saying, "There are the two men." Thomson, whose attention had been attracted by a scuffle which had been taking place a few minutes previously, said, "Let us have a look." On approaching them, Whittaker saw that one was a woman, who was lying motionless. Seizing the man by the collar, Whittaker compelled him to stand up, and held him until he was taken charge of by the police.

Late last night a charge of wilful murder was preferred against Torsell. He did not appear to realise the seriousness of his position, and made a rambling statement about meeting a woman on the wharf earlier in the evening. He said that he supposed the deceased was the same woman, but did not know. He denied having used violence, and seemed to be unable to understand how such an encounter could end fatally.

The accused man, who has recently been living at Port Melbourne, was arrested on a charge of drunkenness only two days ago, and is well known to the police. Latterly he has been constantly in a state of semi-intoxication.

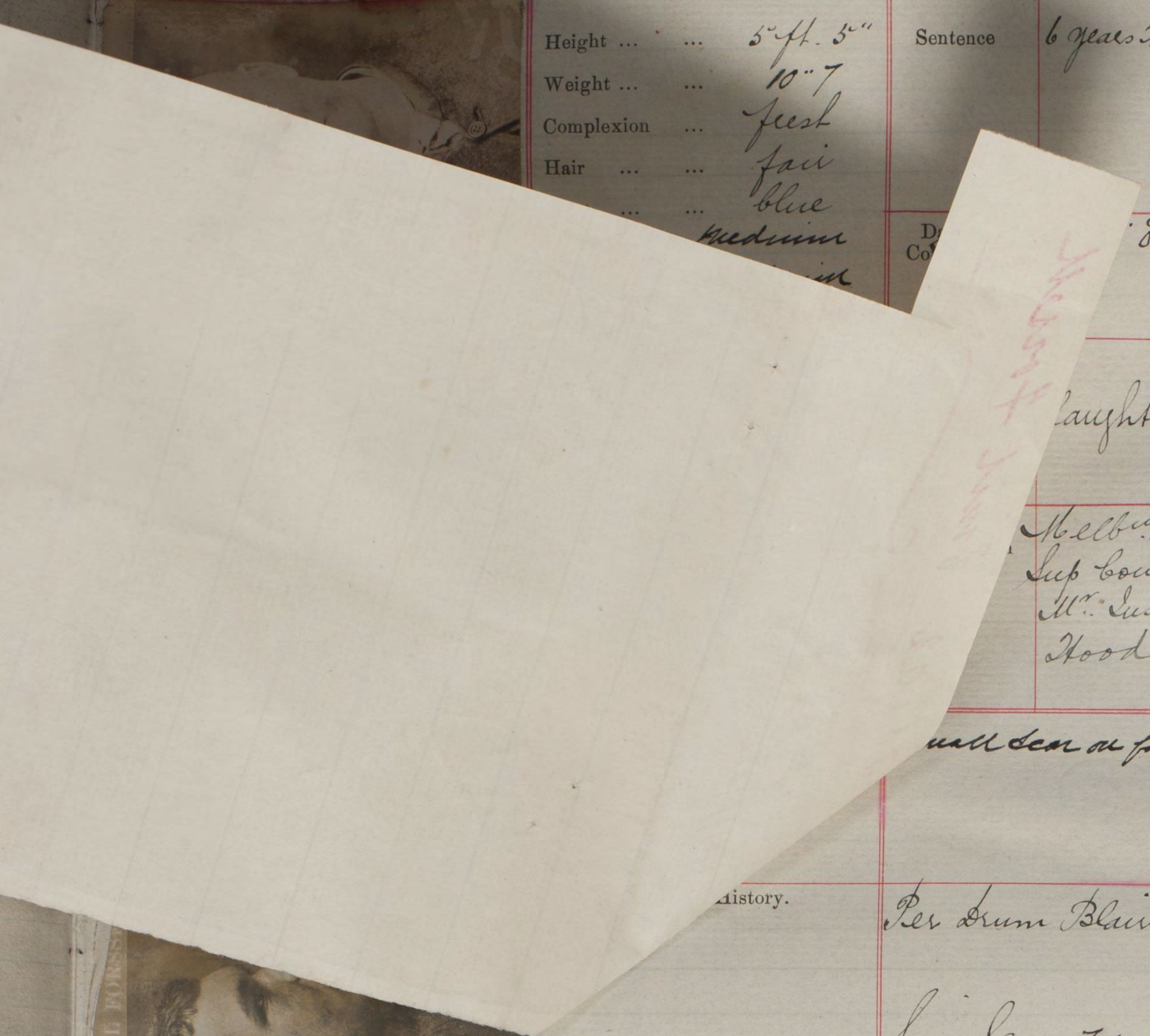
