WOMAN'S REMARKABLE POSITION.
SECOND UNION NULL AND VOID.
THE FIRST DISSOLVED.
 Mr Justice Hodges was called upon to decide a remarkable case in the Divorce Court to-day.
 Francis Mary Glynn (said to have been falsely called Marks), 48 years of age, a dressmaker, residing in Hoddie street, Collingwood, petitioned for a declaration that her marriage with William Edwin Marks, 53 years of age, a contractor, residing in Collingwood, was null and void, on the ground that her previous husband, Stephen Michael Glynn, was alive at the time of the marriage with Marks. She also applied for a divorce from Stephen Michael Glynn, on the ground of desertion.
 Mr Robinson (instructed by Messrs Daly, Hall and Davy) appeared for the petitioner. There was no appearance of either of the respondents.
 According to her affidavit, petitioner was married to Stephen Michael Glynn at Bairnsdale on the 18th September, 1878, and on the 30th June, 1880, she went through the form of a marriage with William Edwin Marks in Melbourne, Pastor Abbot being the celebrant.
 Petitioner said that before marrying Marks she consulted Mr Goswami, who was then Clerk of Petty Sessions, and on her telling him about the former marriage with Glynn, and of his disappearance, he advised her she might safely marry again. She lived with Glynn at various places until 1880. They were then at Ballarat, and Glynn told her to go home to her friends, while he went to Donald to get work. She went to her sister's at Piesborough. He did not write to her as he promised, but he was afterwards taken before the Brunswick Court in March, 1881, on a charge of wife desertion. After that he disappeared, and in 1889 she married Marks as stated, but on hearing that Glynn was still alive, she at once ceased to cohabit with Marks.
 Senior-constable Coster produced the police records and photographs of the respondent Glynn in reference to the prosecution for wife desertion.
 William Gladstone Glynn, a son of the petitioner, deposed that he served the papers in the divorce case Glynn v. Glynn on the respondent at a mining township 500 miles from Sydney, in New South Wales. The witness recognized the respondent immediately on seeing him, and in conversation respondent asked by name about his wife's children.
 His Honor granted a decree, declaring the marriage of the petitioner to William Edwin Marks null and void.
 Further evidence having been given as to the desertion of the petitioner by Stephen Michael Glynn, in 1881, a decree nisi for the dissolution of the marriage with him was granted.
