ROBBERIES BY EMPLOYES.

MR. JUSTICE HOOD AND FIRST
OFFENDERS. 283/6

Several prisoners guilty of robbing their employers came before Mr. Justice Hood at the Criminal Court yesterday for sentence.

A most respectable-looking young man named Cyril Ismay, a clerk, aged 23, who had been guilty of embezzlement, pleaded for leniency and the indulgences of the First Offenders Act.

Mr. Justice Hood—I do not feel disposed to deal with you under the First Offenders Act. The crime of embezzlement can only be committed by a person in a position of trust and of apparent respectability, and by a man violating his trust. And in addition, in your case, your crime was assisted and aggravated by a falsification of books. It is a lamentable thing to see a young man just entering life drifted in among the criminals, and money to you would be cruel to others. If it were to go abroad that a young man of respectable appearance could commit crime and then be treated leniently as a first offender many a weak lad would be driven to a similar offence. Nine months' imprisonment.

Albert Edward Leake, a delicate-looking man, 43 years of age, pleaded guilty to embezzlement.

Mr. Meagher asked for leniency for the prisoner, who, he said, while having opportunities to take large sums of money, had only taken small ones. He had taken a total of £90 in small sums extending over two or three months. When persons came to pay him small sums for his employers he gave them receipts and put the money in his own pocket, but there was no falsification of books.

Mr. Justice Hood.—There is always more temptation to me to display leniency towards first offenders, but that feeling of mine only sways me when that first offence arises through some circumstances of temptation, such as want, when a man steals for a living; but here is a man trusted by his employers, getting a fair salary, making no excuse of want whatever, and so treated by his employers that one of them said on discovering the prisoner's defalcations "if the prisoner had asked for a loan, he would have let him have it. Instead of doing that, prisoner steals their money behind their backs for some purpose which he does not disclose. Nine months' imprisonment."

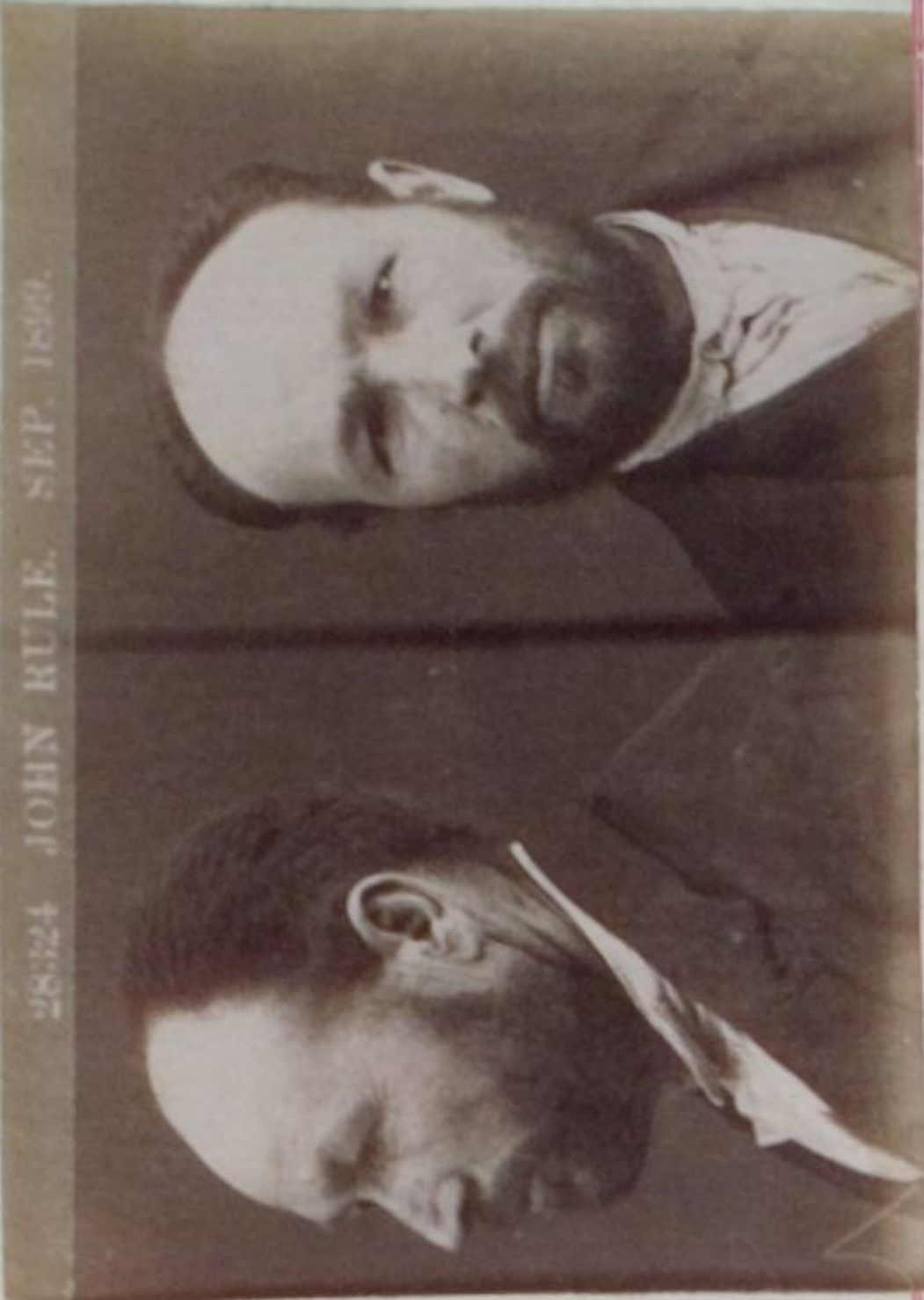

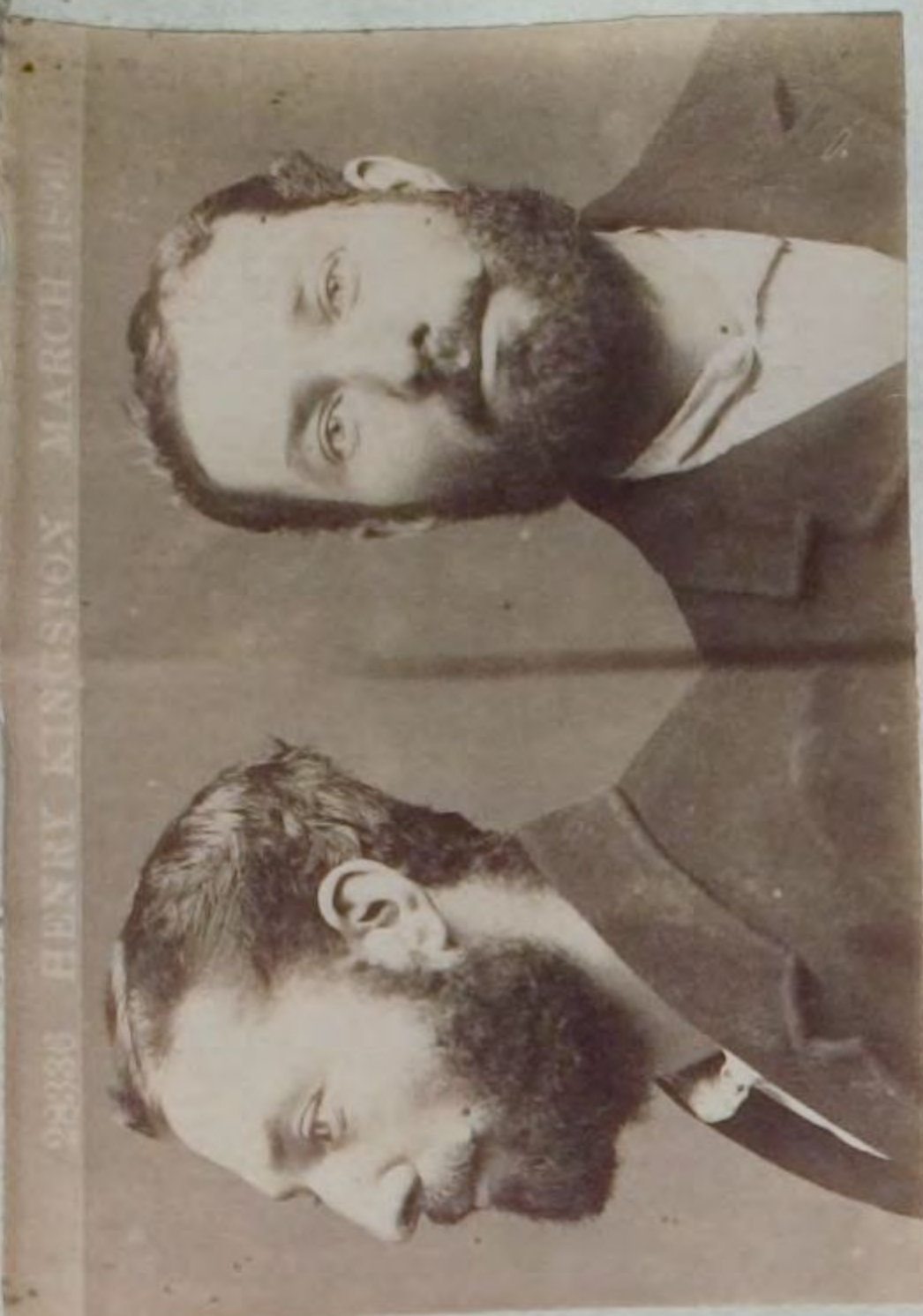
