 Richard Webster, who was convicted and sentenced in February to 12 months' imprisonment for offering for sale brass as gold, was presented for sentence under the Indeterminate Sentences Act. As he had appealed to the July Court of General Sessions against the decision, he was remanded until August.
 Edward Henry Congdon was found guilty on a charge of attempting to assault a young girl named Heywood, near Swan Hill, and was remanded for sentence. Accused's father said he was taken out of an asylum four years ago, but would not remain at home. When he was eight years old he met with an accident to his head.
 A charge of incendiarism against John Mafferson, of Maldon, was heard, and adjourned until the following day.
