The unemployment committee of the Trades Hall Council has convened a meeting of the unemployed, to be held at 3 o'clock on Friday afternoon, at the Trades Hall, when a report will be submitted giving the result of the deputation to Mr. Allan to-day, and a discussion will take place on the question of taking action to relieve the present distress occasioned through unemployment.

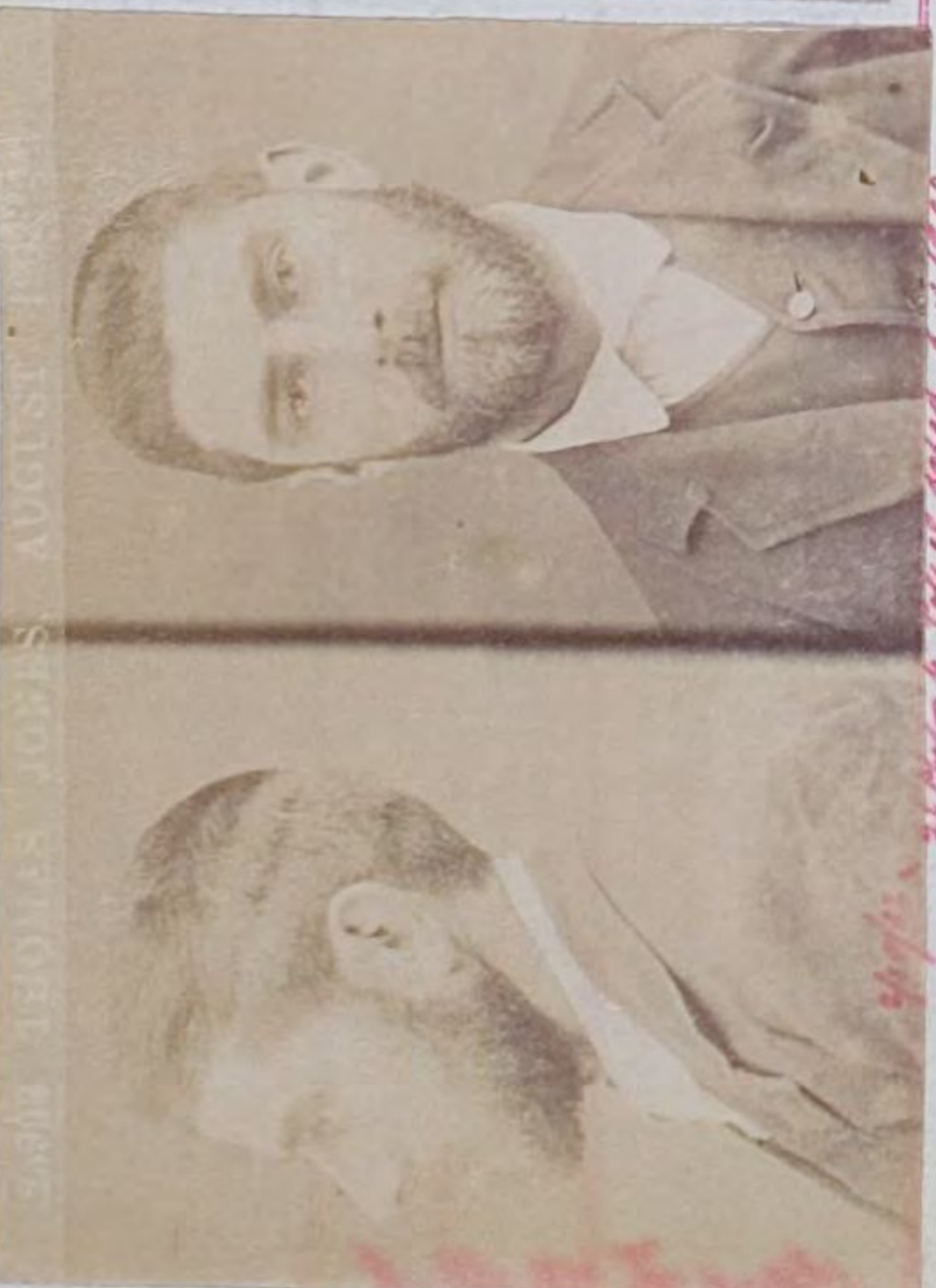
