**CONVICTION AFFIRMED**  
 In the Full Court today judgment was given on an order nisi to review a decision of the Court of Petty Sessions at Williamstown, which sentenced George Eagles to six months' imprisonment. The rule nisi was discharged. The charge against Eagles was laid by Neil Olholm, detective, and was that on April 13, 1914, Eagles was a rogue and vagabond within the meaning of the Police Offences Act 1912, for that he, being a suspected person, loitered in a public place, the flat of Williamstown racecourse, with intent to commit a felony. After the conviction an order nisi to review was obtained on the grounds that the evidence disclosed no offence, and that evidence was wrongly admitted. The Full Court consisted of Mr Justice a'Beckett, Acting Chief Justice; Mr Justice Hodges, and Mr Justice Cussen. In discharging the rule nisi the court held there was evidence before the Justices that Eagles was a suspected person, and also to justify them in concluding that he did loiter on the racecourse with intent to commit a felony. As to the wrongful admission of evidence it was clear that the suspicion that Eagles was a suspected person existed prior to and up to the time of his visit to the racecourse. The conviction of the Court of Petty Sessions was affirmed.

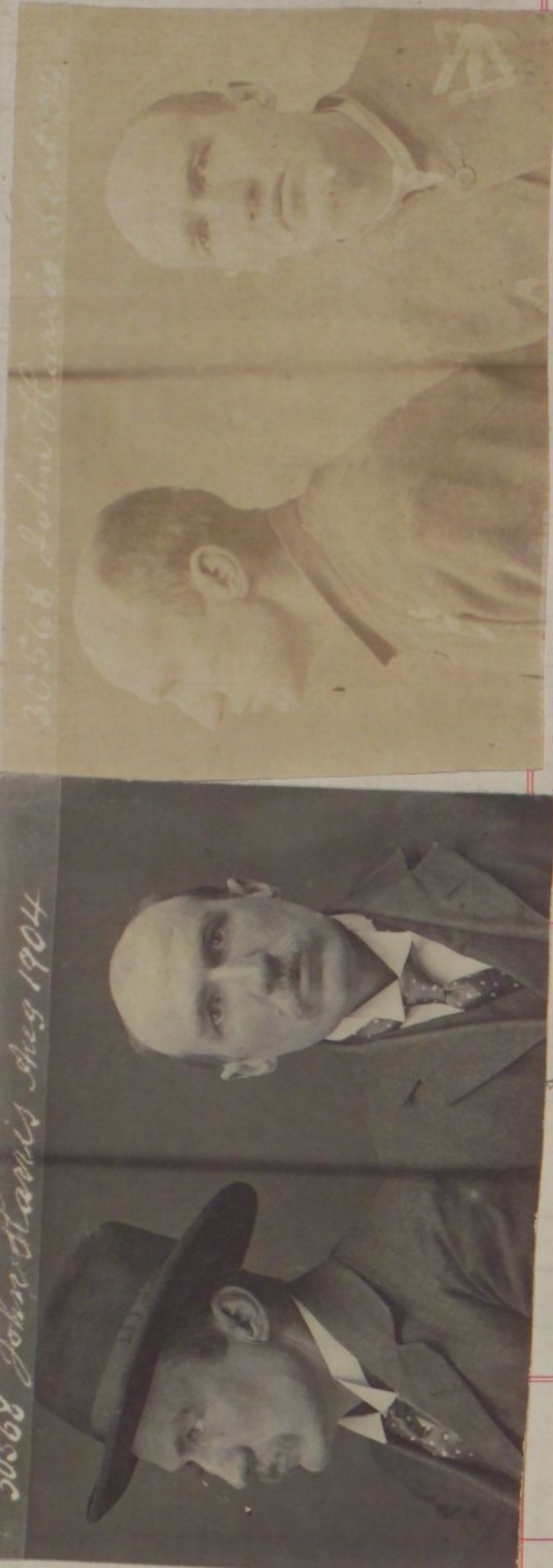
