- When a Payment is made to a person not able to write, the mark of such person is to be vouched by a witness.
- If a Salary is regulated by a Daily Rate, the Daily Rate only; if by an Annual Rate, the Annual Rate only, is to be inserted in the proper column.
- In the case of Daily Salaries, the exact number of days for which each is chargeable is always to be specified, and not merely indicated, by dots to be the same as in the preceding line.
- One-twelfth of an Annual Salary is to be considered the proportion chargeable for each of the successive months of the year of whatever number of days the month may consist.
- The proportion of a Salary for a broken period is to be computed by multiplying the amount of the Monthly or Quarterly Salary, accordingly as the same is payable, Monthly or Quarterly, by the number of days in the broken period, and dividing by the number of days in the Month or Quarter.
- Spaces of lines which do not require to be filled up, should be filled up by drawing a line, to guide the eye, and not by dots.
