A LOVER OF LITERATURE.
GETS A MONTH.
 An intelligent looking youth named Thomas Williams was charged at the City Court to-day with larceny of a book valued at 3s 6d from Cole's Book Arcade yesterday.
 Evidence was given by a salesman employed in the place to the effect that at about half-past two o'clock he saw Williams enter the place, take a book from one of the shelves. Having seen the same man some time ago make off with a book without the employes being able to secure him, witness recognised him and watched him closely yesterday. The book Williams had removed from the shelf he placed under his vest, and quietly sauntered out into Little Collins street, where he was caught and held, pending the arrival of a constable who had been sent for. Williams resented the action of his captor, whom he threatened to "smash" unless he was released. It transpired in Court to-day that accused was a ward of the State, having been in the Industrial Schools.
 Mr Panton, addressing Williams, said that as a ward of the State, there was no excuse for his adopting a life of crime. The State had not only maintained him, but had given him his education, which should have been applied to some useful purpose.
 Williams (impudently): Excuse me; my father paid for me all the time I was in the schools, so that I don't, as you say, owe the State anything. I can get work in about a month, and I'll got to it if you let me off.
 Mr Panton asked what was known of the lad, and was informed that he had several times been before the Court on charges of larceny and discharged. Addressing the accused, Mr Panton then said, "You say you can get work in a month. Very well you will go to gaol on this charge for a month, and I hope that on your release you will go to the work you say you can get. Don't come here again, as I warn you that if you do you will be remembered, and be awarded such punishment as will be a warning to you."
