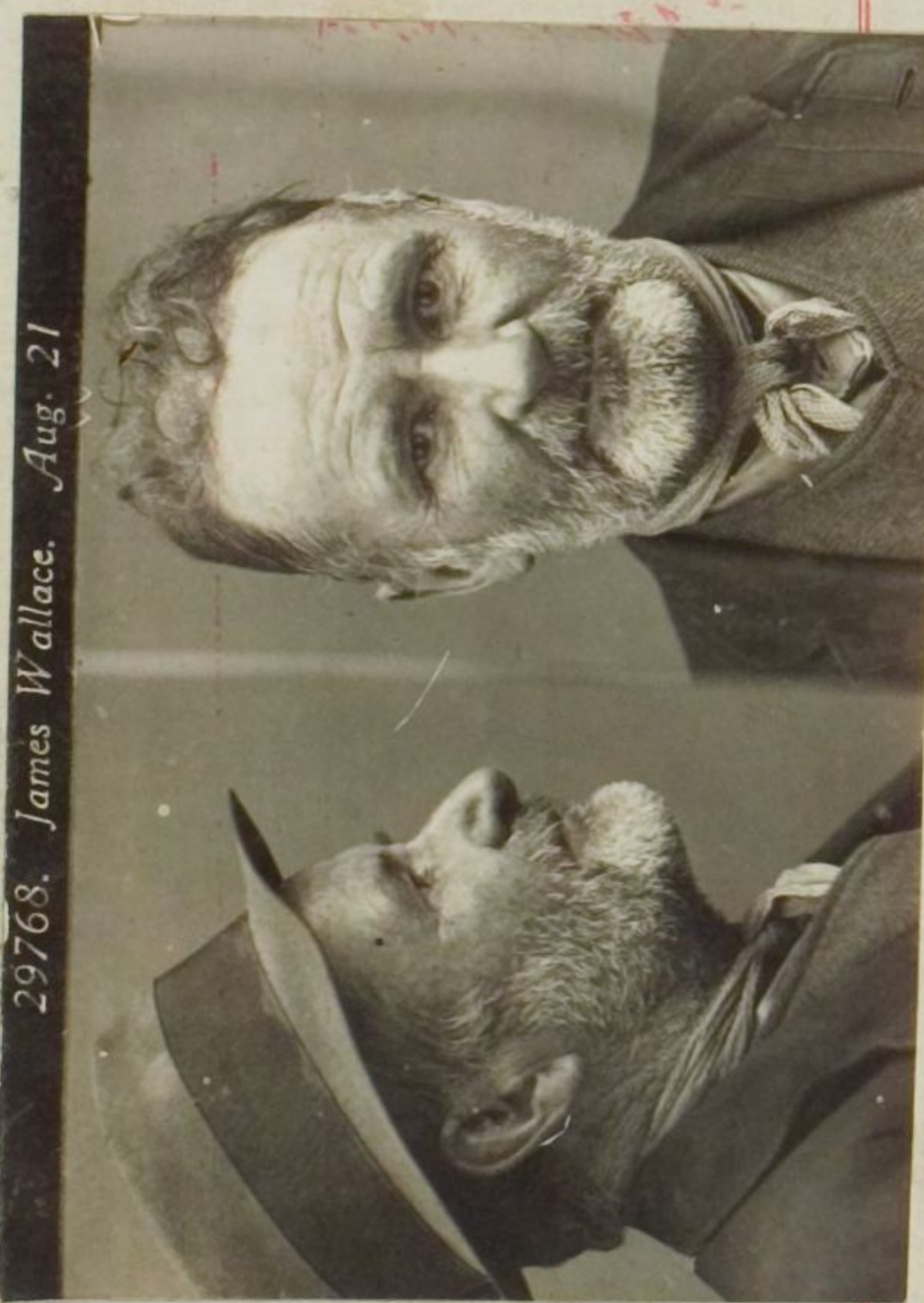

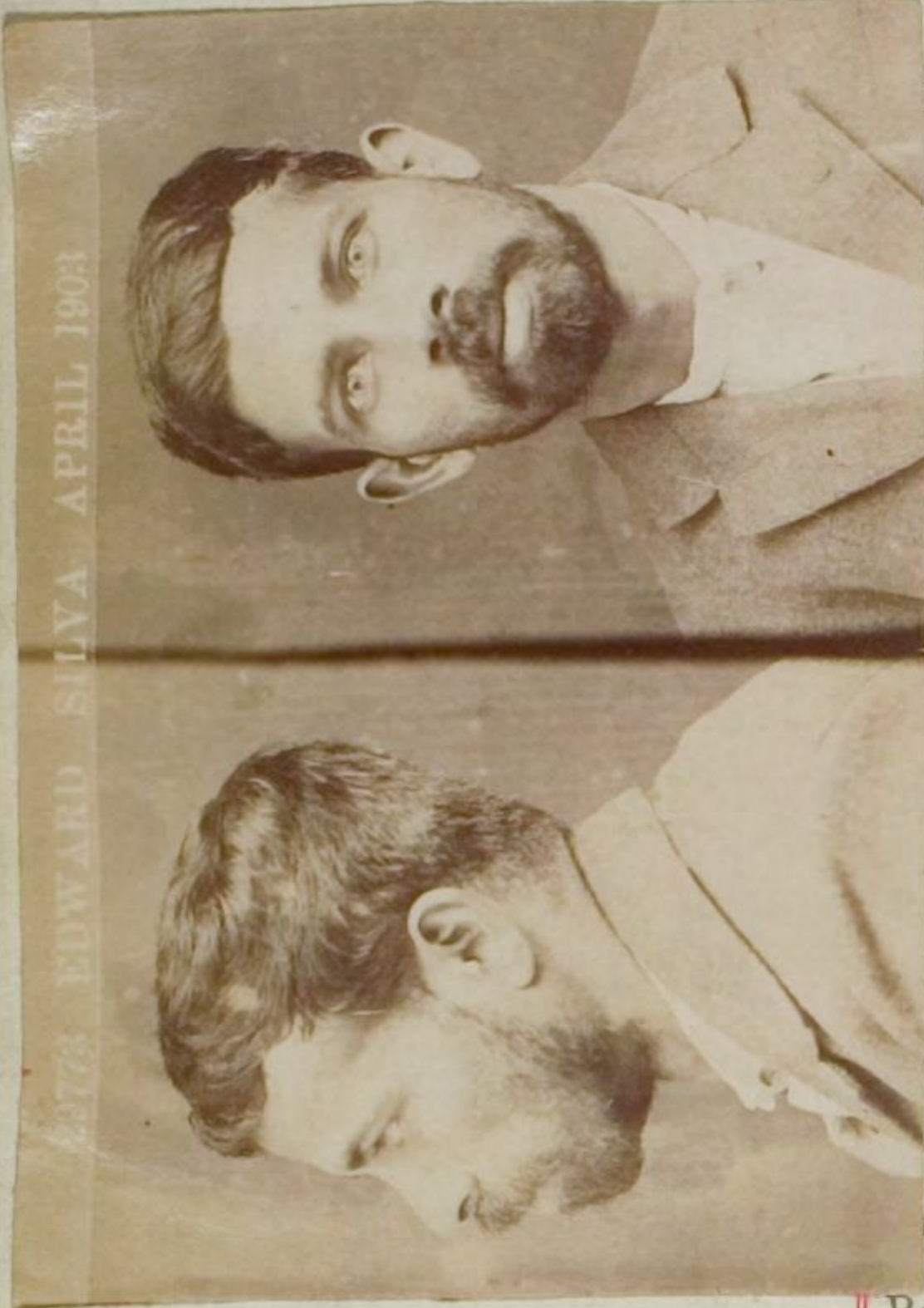

OLD CRIMINAL DIES.

EIGHTY-FIVE YEARS OF SENTENCES.

On Tuesday, in the Geelong Gaol, a famous old criminal died peacefully. He was Frederick Clarke—better known as Josh. Clarke, and still more familiarly known as "The Last of the Lags." Clarke was born in Yorkshire in 1829, but though only 75 years of age, he had received since 1847 sentences of imprisonment amounting to 85 years and 7 months.

Clarke's first introduction to Australasia was under unhappy auspices. He came to "Van Diemen's Land" in 1847, in the ship "Eliza," under a sentence of transportation for 10 years. Gaining his ticket-of-leave, he came to Victoria in 1852 by the ship "Gold-seeker," and set himself to seek for gold in his own peculiar manner. By April, 1853, he had gained a sentence of two years' imprisonment for vagrancy, and immediately after his release, in November, 1854, he stole a horse, and received a sentence of 10 years' hard labour on the roads. Good conduct enabled him to complete his sentence in 1860, but soon after being set free he stole another horse, and was sentenced to seven years "on the roads."

Thus far his sentences had reached 27 years. His later record runs—May, 1865, six months (intent to commit a felony); June, 1865 (larceny), three years "in the public works;" May, 1869, two cumulative sentences of three years each (for stealing); August, 1874, five years (store-breaking); December, 1878, two years (receiving); and between 1880 and 1902 six sentences for larceny and receiving, making in all 40 years; and an additional sentence of two years for escaping from the Geelong Gaol in 1889. His last sentence was in February, 1902, when he received four years for attempted larceny.

Only once—in his very last sentence—were the sentences made concurrent. Clarke managed to cram 85 years of sentences into 57 years of life by his good conduct while in gaol, for he was always a model prisoner. His appearance, in his later days, was that of an honest and innocent old gentleman, though he was a member of the notorious "Plum" Gang, one of the most famous bodies of criminals in Victoria, named from their leader, "Plum" Williams.

Larceny had become an irresistible habit with Clarke. "He did but steal because he must." Once, after completing a sentence, he went to Captain Evans, then inspector-general of prisons, asking for help to set himself up as a barber (though his official "occupation" in the records is set down variously as sailor or whitesmith). Captain Evans gave him an order on a cutlery firm for several razors. Clarke bought the razors, and, after he left it was discovered that a dozen other razors had also gone. "Why did you do it?" Captain Evans asked when next he saw Clarke in Pentridge. "They were there, Captain," answered the prisoner, "and I just had to take them."

Of late years Clarke had dropped into a low place in the criminal caste, his most recent offences being the theft of a pair of scissors.
