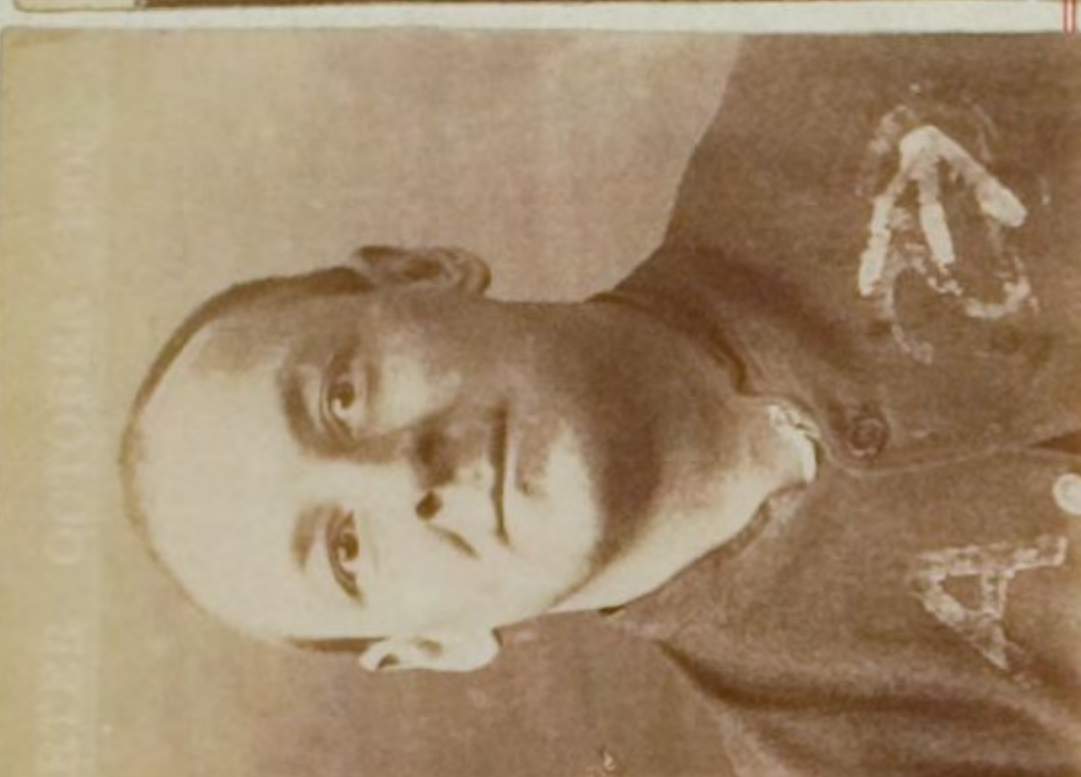

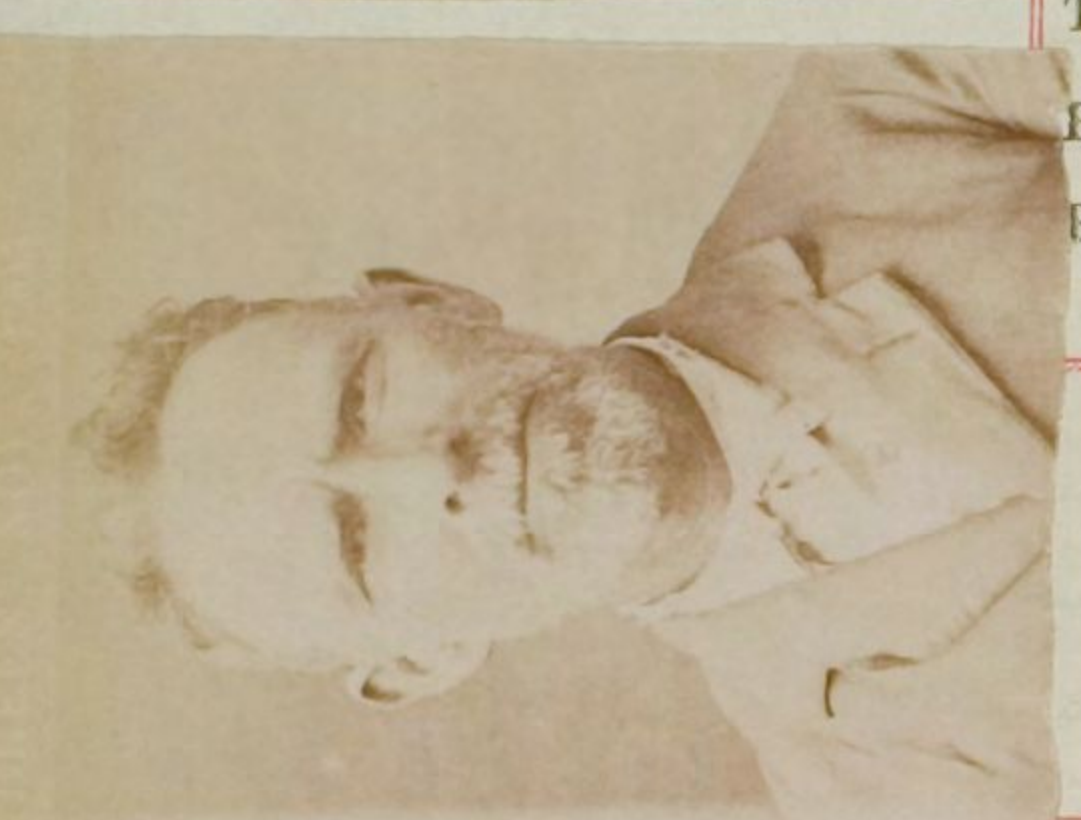

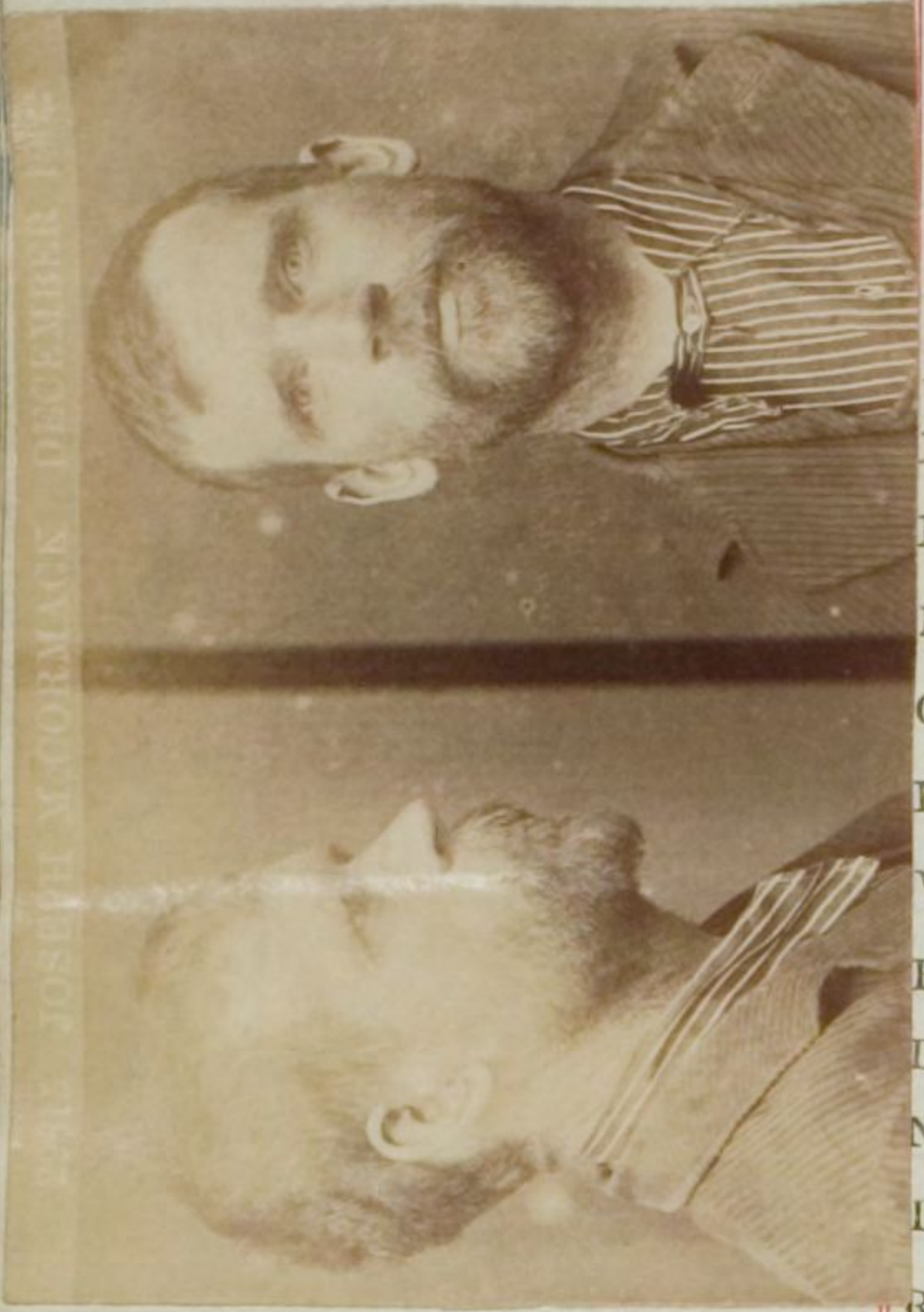

A PETITION FOR MERCY.

OBTAINING THE RELEASE OF PRISONERS.

FORGERY SUSPECTED.

All manner of tricks are resorted to from time to time by the friends of prisoners to obtain their release; and the statements made on their behalf to the Crown Law department are often, when weighed in the judicial scales, found to be wanting—both in truth and in fact. A case in point was mentioned yesterday by the Attorney-General. In an attempt to get a convicted person released before his sentence had expired, it seems as though someone had committed forgery in writing a young woman's name, both to a letter and a petition for mercy.

The case concerns that of a young man named Michael Quigley, who is now an inmate of the Geelong gaol. He was convicted at a sitting of the Supreme Court in May, 1890, on a charge of assaulting a young woman, and was sentenced to ten years hard labor, with periods of solitary confinement, and it was also ordered that he should receive a flogging. A month following the imposition of the sentence a petition was received by the Crown Law department asking that the flogging should not be carried out, as the youth—he was only 19 years of age—was in weak health. A report obtained from the gaol medical officer, however, did not bear out this assertion, and the flogging was duly administered. Since that time nearly a dozen petitions, asking for the release of the prisoner on various grounds, have been presented, being on the average at the rate of two each year; but a refusal has followed in each case. Owing to ill-health, Quigley was removed from Pentridge to Geelong, and the latest reports received concerning him were to the effect that he was improving in health. To the most recent petition received by the department there was attached the name of the young woman the prisoner had assaulted, and also the names of some of her relations. Later on a letter purporting to be written by the young woman herself reached the Minister. This stated that the writer "was thoroughly satisfied" with the punishment Quigley had received and a request was made that he be released. The department courteously wrote to the young woman, stating that the Attorney-General had decided to make no recommendation to the Governor in Council on behalf of the prisoner. In reply to this communication, the young woman wrote back, stating that she failed to understand the meaning of the letter sent to her. She had not, she said, written any letter asking that the prisoner should be released, and had no desire that he should be liberated until the full term of his sentence had expired. She also denied having signed any petition asking for clemency to be shown him. The writing in the letter written by the young woman is, it may be stated, of quite a different kind to that in the presumably fictitious communication supposed to have been sent by her to the Attorney-General.

The matter is regarded by Mr. Davies as being a very serious one, and he has ordered that a strict investigation be made into the circumstances.
