and administer according to law, to the best of *their* knowledge and ability the property lands
and hereditaments goods chattels and credits of the said deceased at the time of his death
which at any time after shall come to the power or control hands or possession of *them*
as his *Executors* or of any other person or persons for *them*
that *they* will make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the
property lands and hereditaments goods chattels and credits of the said deceased which shall
have come to the hands possession or knowledge of *them* or to the hands or possession of any
other person or persons for *them* and the same so made will sign with *their* proper hands
writing and will exhibit and deposit or cause to be exhibited and deposited the same inventory
in the office of the Master in Equity within three calendar months next ensuing the order
granting Probate herein and further that *they* will make or cause to be made a true and
just account of the administration of the estate which *they have* undertaken as to *their*
receipts and disbursements and as to what portion is retained by *them* and what portion remains
uncollected and the same so made will sign with *their* proper handwriting and will exhibit
and deposit or cause to be exhibited and deposited the same account in the said office of the
Master in Equity within fifteen calendar months next ensuing the order granting Probate herein
as aforesaid pursuant to the rules of this Honourable Court and that *they* believe the said
