I Maria Louisa Chalker of 31 Agnes Street Folimont Spinner
 declare this to be my last Will and Testament I revoke all
 former testamentary dispositions made by me I appoint as executor
 and trustee of this my will Benjamin Newport White of East
 Melbourne clerk in Holy Orders I give to the said Benjamin
 Newport White my three papier mache trays; to Mrs Boulton the wife
 of D: Boulton of Collins Street Melbourne my blue willow pattern
 dishes cups saucers and plates; to James Brooks of 31 Agnes
 Street aforesaid my furniture and other articles in my dining
 room and kitchen; to the persons to whom they are addressed
 any parcels I may leave so prepared and addressed.
 After payment of all my debts funeral and testamentary expenses
 I give devise and bequeath the rest of my personal property and
 all my real estate unto my said trustee upon the following trusts.

1. To sell call in and convert into money all my estate.
2. To pay to the legal representatives of my late cousin Jane
 Elizabeth Catherine Wallis late of 105 St Mary's Street Weymouth
 Dorset the sum of Two hundred pounds which I owe.
3. To divide the rest and residue of my estate into five equal
 shares and to pay one of such shares to each of the following
 persons the said James Brooks, Ada Wallis, Ellen (or Nellie)
 Wallis, George Hodges Wallis (the daughters and son of the said
 Jane Elizabeth Catherine Wallis) and the wife of my cousin Clifford
 Chalker of Weymouth aforesaid Antisiever.
4. In the event of such residue as referred to in clause 3 hereof not
 amounting to Five hundred pounds to pay out of such residue
 the sum of one hundred pounds to the said James Brooks and
 to divide the balance between the other four persons mentioned in
 clause 3. And in the event of any of the five persons referred
 to in clause 3 predeceasing me I direct that his her or their
 shares shall go into and form part of the residue of my
 estate.
5. I direct that my said trustee shall for his trouble receive the
 usual commission of two and a half per cent.

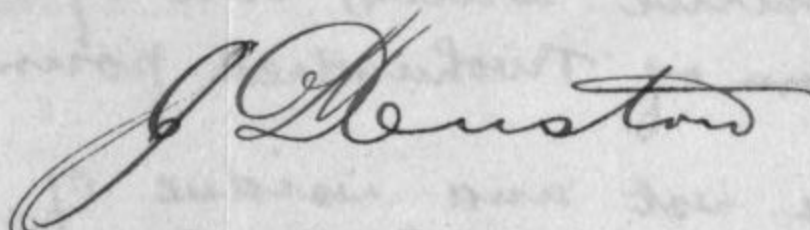
