This is the Last Will and Testament of me Catherine Curran, of Number 295 Latrobe Terrace, Geelong in the State of Victoria, Married woman.

I revoke all other Wills by me heretofore made.

I appoint Annie Ellen Curran, of the aforesaid address, Executrix of this my last Will.

I give, devise and bequeath unto my beloved daughter, Annie Ellen Curran, of the aforesaid address, Spinister, my "Beale" piano.

I give, devise and bequeath, unto my beloved daughters, Annie Ellen Curran, aforesaid, Spinister, and Kathleen Mary Curran, of St. Vincent's Hospital, Fitzroy, Nurse, all my real Estate, and the rest of my personal Estate, to be divided between them, in equal proportions.

In the event of either of my daughters - predeceasing me, I direct and bequeath the deceased's share to revert to my surviving daughter.

In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand, this thirtieth day of June One Thousand, Nine Hundred and twenty-three.
