- 1 That I am well acquainted with the above named

- 2 That in the Christmas week of last year he requested me
to draw out a will for him, which I did, it being partly
written. I filled in the same in accordance with his in-
structions leaving the date unfilled, but putting in
the month and year as it was his intention to sign it
shortly.
- 3 That the same will that I drew out is hereto annexed
and marked A and I am one of the two witnesses to
its execution.
- 4 That the said Will was executed or signed by the said
Testator Carl Esther on ^{the} following Monday being
Monday the Twenty eighth day of December one
thousand eight hundred and eighty six at Testator's
residence the "Alliance Hotel" corner of Camp Street
and High Street Beechworth. to which place I took it
on that day.
- 5 It was signed in the presence of me this deponent
and one Steenrich Grinnell who was residing at
the deceased's Hotel at the time, but who is now lying
ill at the Beechworth Hospital.
