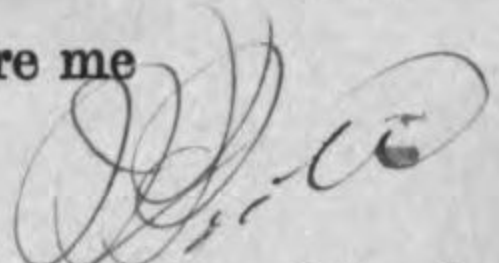

Referring to yours of 3<sup>rd</sup> inst:  
at the date of death of deceased  
was informed by the Building Society  
that £50 was amount of deposit.  
I therefore had statement prepared  
accordingly. On realization I  
found that deposit was £150 but  
against that sum £100 had been  
advanced by way of loan, so the  
net asset in the Estate was still  
£50. That item in the statement  
is therefore for all practical purposes  
correct. After probate was obtained  
I arranged with Walker to extend  
the time of payment of his  
mortgage debt if he would pay  
interest at 5% from 24<sup>th</sup> March
