This is the last will and Testament of me Samuel Coupland of Bonnie Doon Fincorn Street East Malvern Victoria Gentleman, I appoint Walter Joseph Arnold of 312 Drummond Street Carlton Piano Warehouseman and Harry Johnston of Laetgarth Street Northcote Builder (hereinafter called "my Trustees") Executors and Trustees of this my will I give devise and bequeath the whole of my estate and property both real and personal of or to which I shall die possessed or entitled to my Trustees upon trust as to the following articles in the front bedroom at Bonnie Doon aforesaid viz: the bedstead & mattress boardbed Duchess table, washstand, Chest of drawers and carpet and also the following articles in the Front room viz: the suite in blue silk, the overmantel and draught table for my daughter Mrs May Johnston to whom I give and bequeath the same absolutely and upon trust as to my music whether in books or otherwise to divide the same to the best of their ability equally between my daughter Mrs May Johnston, my son William Henry Coupland, my daughter Harriet Coupland and William Dawson Davis of Taranaki New Zealand Music Dealer to whom I give and bequeath the same absolutely and upon trust as to the rest of my furniture for my step daughter Alice Davis of Bonnie Doon aforesaid to whom I give and bequeath the same absolutely by the word "furniture"
