This is the Last Will and Testament

of me
Leopold Frederick Collin of "Fetterearin" The Avenue Windsor in the
 State of Victoria Music Warehouseman. I give devise and bequeath all
 and singular the real and personal estate of which I shall be possessed
 at the date of my decease whatsoever and wheresoever situated unto The
Equity Trustees Executors and Agency Company Limited of No 85
 Queen Street Melbourne Upon trust to stand possessed of the whole of
 my trust estate and to deal with the same in the manner and subject to
 the trusts hereinafter declared that is to say: I direct my said Trustee
 immediately after my decease to pay the sum of one hundred and fifty
 Pounds to each of my Daughters Julia Matilda Collin, Bertha Pauline
Collin, Rose Janet Burke and Maria Maria Black and the sum of
 one hundred and fifty Pounds to each of my Sons Robert Frederick
Collin and Albert Frederick Collin such respective sums to be as a
 provision for the immediate necessities of each of my said Daughters and
 Sons respectively. I direct my said Trustee as soon after my decease as
 my said Trustee shall deem it most expedient so to do so as to ensure the
 best possible price being obtained for same to sell realize and convert the
 whole or such part of my estate both real and personal not hereby otherwise
 disposed of either by public auction or private contract in one or several lots
 and upon such terms and subject to such conditions of sale as my said
 Trustees may consider necessary and with respect to my business of Music
 Warehouseman now carried on by me at Swanston Street Melbourne
 including the goodwill, stock, book debts and all other the assets thereof,
 either as a going concern or in such other manner and at such times as my
 said Trustee may deem necessary or expedient and with full power and
 authority to my said Trustee to continue and carry on my said business
 until the sale thereof as hereinbefore directed without being answerable or
 responsible for any involuntary loss which may be occasioned thereby. And
 to stand possessed of the proceeds to arise from such sale and conversion
 and after payment thereof of all my just debts funeral and testamentary
 expenses including Probate Duty payable on my estate and all costs of and
 incidental to the proving of this my Will and the charges and expenses of
 realization and distribution of my trust estate to invest the sum of Five
Hundred Pounds in any of the investments authorized by law for the
 investment of trust funds with full power and authority to my said Trustee
 from time to time to alter or vary any such investments and to pay and
 apply the income to arise therefrom from time to time for the maintenance
 education benefit or support of my Great Grandson Edward Burke
 until he shall attain the age of Twenty one years, and upon his attaining
 the age of Twenty one years I direct my said Trustee to call in and
 realize the said sum of Five hundred Pounds and to pay such sum
 together with all accumulations thereon (if any) unto the said Edward
Burke for his own use and benefit absolutely. And as to the residue
 of the proceeds arising from the sale and conversion of my said estate
 I direct my said Trustee to divide the same into Seven equal shares and
 proportions and to deal with such shares and proportions in the manner following
 that is to say: I direct my said Trustee to pay one of such shares and
 proportions to each of my Daughters the said Julia Matilda, Bertha
Pauline and Rose Janet as soon as the same are available for payment

for their own respective use and benefit absolutely. I direct my said Trustee to pay one of such shares and proportions as soon as the same are available for payment unto my Grandson Reginald Rudd commonly known by adoption as Reginald Burke for his own use and benefit absolutely. I direct my said Trustee to set apart one of such shares and proportions and to invest the same in any of the investments as heretofore mentioned for a period of Three years from the date the amount of such share is available for investment. And I further direct my said Trustee to pay and apply during the term of such investment the income to be derived therefrom to my said Daughter Marie Teresa by equal quarterly payments for her own separate use and benefit. And immediately after the expiration of the said term of Three years I direct my said Trustee to call in and realize the amount of such share and pay the same unto my said Daughter Marie Teresa for her own use and benefit absolutely. I direct my said Trustee to set apart one of such shares and proportions and to invest the same in the manner heretofore mentioned for a period of Five years from the date the amount of such share is available for investment. And I further direct my said Trustee to pay and apply during the term of such investment the income to be derived therefrom to my Son the said Robert Frederick Collin such income to be paid by equal quarterly payments to my said Son for his own use and benefit. And immediately after the expiration of the said term of Five years I direct my said Trustee to call in and realize the amount of such share and pay the same unto my said Son Robert Frederick Collin for his own use and benefit absolutely. I direct my said Trustee to set apart the remaining one share and proportion of such proceeds as aforesaid and to invest the same in the manner heretofore mentioned for a period of Five years from the date the amount of such share is available for investment. And I further direct my said Trustee to pay and apply during the term of such investment the income to be derived therefrom to my said Son Albert Frederick Collin such income to be paid by equal quarterly payments to my said Son for his own use and benefit. And immediately after the expiration of the said term of Five years I direct my said Trustee to call in and realize the amount of such share and pay the same unto my said Son Albert Frederick Collin for his own use and benefit absolutely. I declare that if either or both of my said Sons Robert Frederick and Albert Frederick shall without leaving lawful issue die before me or before the expiration of the said term of Five years during which their respective shares shall be so invested as aforesaid that the share or shares of either or both of my said Sons so dying as aforesaid shall be paid and divided between my said Daughters Julia Matilda, Bertha Pauline, Rose Janet and Marie Teresa and my Grandson the said Reginald Burke or such of them as shall be living at the date of the death of my said Sons respectively for their own use and benefit absolutely in equal shares and proportions. I further direct that should either or both of my said Sons die before me or before the expiration of the said term of Five years leaving lawful issue then such issue of my said Sons respectively shall take and if more than one equally between

them the share to which his her or their parent would have been ~~as~~
entitled under the trusts hereof. I appoint the said The ~~as~~
Equity Trustees Executors and Agency Company Limited Sole ~~as~~
Executor of this my Will and lastly I hereby revoke all former
testamentary dispositions and declare this to be my true last Will
and Testament. **In Witness** whereof I have hereunto
set my hand this ~~7th~~ day of October one
thousand nine hundred and eleven.
