This is the last Will and Testament OF ME

Daniel William Knight Goodall known as William Daniel Goodall of 107 Edgevale Road East New in the State of Victoria Musician, And I appoint Henry William Goodall of 6 Wallace Grove Middle Brighton, and Cecil Albert Bond of (Yurunga) Prospect Hill Road Canterbury Executors and Trustees of this my Will (hereinafter called my Trustees) after payment of my just debts funeral and testamentary expenses,

I GIVE devise and bequeath unto my Trustees my Property known as Yeta situated at 69 Bell Street Fitzroy + also all my interest in (Elenosken 1270- Bell Street Fitzroy) aforesaid upon trust for all my Children, viz Augusta Maria Grove, Evangeline Dupree Down, Henry William Goodall, Frederick Knight Goodall, John Rupert Goodall, Minnie May Jane Bric Knell, and Emmie Alberta Bond, and I direct my said Trustees to sell and dispose of my said property whenever requested in Writing so to do by the majority of my said Children and the net Proceeds arising from such sale to be divided equally between all my hereinbefore mentioned Children and until such sale, I direct that the income obtainable from the said property shall be divided between all my said Children in equal shares, And in the event of any child or Children of mine occupying either of the Houses he or they shall pay a fair rental for the same such rental to be divided equally between all my said Children, I give and bequeath to my said Son Henry William Goodall the Family Pictures in Oil also my three Masonic Pictures, I give and bequeath unto my Trustees the remainder of my pictures and other effects upon trust to divide the same between all my said Children in equal shares such division to be decided upon by a majority of my said Children but in the event of a majority of my said Children declining to sell such pictures + Property then I direct my said Trustees to effect such sale and to divide the proceeds arising therefrom equally between all my said Children, I give devise and bequeath the residue of my real and personal estate unto my said Children share and share alike Provided always and I declare that if any child of mine shall die in my lifetime leaving issue surviving me the bequest and division herein contained to any such child shall not lapse but shall as to such issue in equal shares upon attaining the age of twenty one years and if there shall be no such issue then my said child's share under this my Will shall be equally divided between the survivor or survivors of my said Children, Provided further that if any beneficiary or beneficiaries hereunder shall object to, combat, or take any proceedings to upset this my Will then I direct that the share of such beneficiary shall be divided equally amongst the remainder of my said Children.
