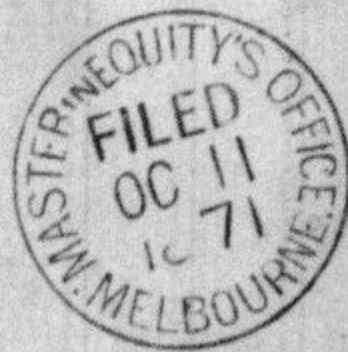

administration of the ^{estate of the} said deceased within fifteen months
of the said Order pursuant to the Rules of this Honorable
Court

Victoria aforesaid does not exceed in value ~~Three~~ hundred
pounds Sterling

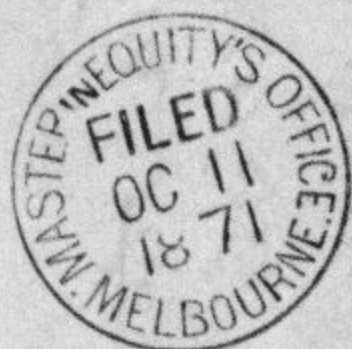

I. Thomas Bannister of mrs
Castlemaine in the colony of
Victoria Inn Keeper declare this
to be my Will - I give and be-
queath to my Grand daughter
Amy Osea the sum of One Hundred
Pounds Sterling to be paid to her if
and when she shall attain the age of
Twenty three years and to my Grand
daughter Jane Osea the like sum of
One hundred pounds Sterling to be
paid to her if and when she shall
attain the age of twenty one years.
Subject to the payment of the said legacies
and to the payment of my just debts my
funeral and testamentary expenses
and also to the payment of any mortgage
debt which may be due upon my
freehold property. I give devise
and bequeath all my Estate real and
personal whatsoever and wheresoever
unto my wife Sarah. and I appoint
my said wife and Nicholas Tibbald
of Castlemaine Brewer executrix and
Executor of this my Will. mrs

In Witness whereof I have here to
set my hand this fourth day of August
in the Year of our Lord one thousand Eight
hundred and Seventy one *
