make oath and say—

1. That I am seeking to obtain Probate of the Will of the above-named James Ferguson deceased.
2. The said deceased died on the third day of April
One thousand eight hundred and eighty eight
3. The said deceased left a Will bearing date the fifth day
of December One thousand eight hundred and seventy one
which is as I believe the last Will and Testament of the said deceased
and which is unrevoked unless the same was revoked
by a Will alleged to have been executed by the said
deceased in or about the month of March One thousand
eight hundred and eighty two
4. By his said Will the said testator appointed me this deponent

his lawful Widow sole executrix thereof.

5. The paper writing hereunto annexed marked "A" is the true last Will of the said deceased as I verily believe unless the same was revoked by the said Will alleged to have been executed by the said deceased in the said month of March
6. The said Will was executed in the presence of George Henry Taylor
of Queen Street Melbourne in the said Colony
Solicitor and Arthur Henry Manton of Queen
Street Melbourne aforesaid Solicitor
7. The said deceased left real estate in the Colony of Victoria not exceeding in value the sum of One hundred and three thousand pounds
and personal property in the said Colony not exceeding in value the sum of Thirty eight thousand pounds.

8. If *I* obtain Probate *I* will well and truly collect and administer according to law to the best of *my* knowledge and ability the property lands and hereditaments goods chattels and credits of the said deceased at the time of *his* death which at any time after shall come to the power or control hands or possession of *me* as *his* executors or any other person or persons for *me* that *I* will make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the property lands and hereditaments goods chattels and credits of the said deceased which shall have come to the hands possession or knowledge of *me* or to the hands or possession of any other person or persons for *me* and the same so made will sign with *my* proper hand writing and will exhibit and deposit or cause to be exhibited and deposited the same inventory in the office of the Master-in-Equity within three calendar months next ensuing the order granting probate and further that *I* will make or cause to be made a true and just account of the administration of the estate which *I* have undertaken as to *my* receipts and disbursements and as to what portion is retained by *me* and what portion remains uncollected and the same so made will sign with *my* proper hand writing and will exhibit and deposit or cause to be exhibited and deposited the same account in the said office of the Master-in-Equity within fifteen calendar months next ensuing the order granting probate.
