best, and I hereby appoint Jane Delahenty

my daughter, Executor of my Will, in witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
this second day of January, in the year of  
Our Lord, nineteen hundred and three (1903)

and Testament in the presence of us, present at the  
same time, who in her presence, at her request, and  
in the presence of each other, have hereunto subscribed
