This is the Last Will of me Elizabeth
Savage of "The Unchorage" Berwick
Married Woman I appoint the National
Trusts Executors and Agency Company of
Australia Limited my husband Edward
Savage and Peter James McQuade of Chesham
Roadkeeper executors and trustees of this my
Will I bequeath to the respective Parish Priests
in charge of St John Berthmans R.C. Church
Camdenwell, the Roman Catholic Church Berwick
The Church of the Immaculate Conception Kew
and the Church of our Lady of Mount Carmel
Middle Park the sum of ten pounds each for
masses to be offered up for the repose of my
soul and the souls of my husband, my
deceased father mother and brothers I direct
my trustees to set apart the sum of one hundred
pounds and expend the same as much as may
be necessary in keeping my grave in order and
repair I bequeath my watch and chain to
my adopted daughter Elizabeth Campbell
wife of W. H. Campbell of Mildura I direct my
trustees to pay the net rents income and profits
from all the real and personal property of my
husband Edward Savage during his life to be
paid to him by monthly payments, but all
rates and taxes costs of insurance and repairs
shall first be deducted therefrom After the
death of my husband I devise my property
known as No 14 and 16 Invermay Gate Auburn
upon trust that my trustees shall pay or apply

The net rents there of after payment of all rates taxes costs of insurance and repairs thereof to and towards the maintenance and education of all the children or any the child of the said Elizabeth Campbell whether born in my lifetime or not until he she or they shall respectively attain the age of twentyone years with power to my trustees to apply the same themselves or to pay it to the guardian of such ~~guardian~~ children a child without seeing to the application thereof and after the youngest of such children shall have attained the aforesaid age I direct that such property shall be sold and the net proceeds of such sale shall be paid to such of the children of the said Elizabeth Campbell as shall be then living and if more than one then in equal shares After the death of my husband I bequeath my shares in the Metropolitan Gas Company and in the Commercial Bank of Australia Ltd to such of the children of the said Elizabeth Savage as shall then be living and shall have or shall attain the age of 21 years But in the ^{until the youngest of them is 21 years of age} meantime the dividends and bonuses if any on such shares shall be paid to the said Elizabeth ^{Campbell} Savage I direct that my husband's funeral expenses shall be paid out of my estate After the death of my husband I direct my trustees to realise the rest and residue of my estate and out of the proceeds to pay the following legacies viz. to the Rev Father Conlan of Clifton £11 five pounds and to the ^{and to the Rev Francis Xavier College of St. Mary's} Sisters of the Holy Sacrament £5 five pounds and to pay and discharge the balance

equally to and between The Roman Catholic
Church at Brunswick, The Little Sisters of the Poor
at Northcote, The Convent of the Good Shepherd
at Alton and The Roman Catholic
Archbishop of Melbourne for the time being
to be used by him for the proposed College at
The Melbourne University, but without
obligation on my trustees to see to the application
thereof. Notwithstanding the trusts hereinbefore
contained I decree (after the death of my husband)
my land in the township of Koroitewarra to
my adopted son John James Edward Savage.
I give my trustees full power to lease
re-lease improve and insure and to
realise all or any part of my residuary
estate during the lifetime of my husband
but only with his consent in writing
first obtained. As witness my hand this
twenty-first day of December 1915
