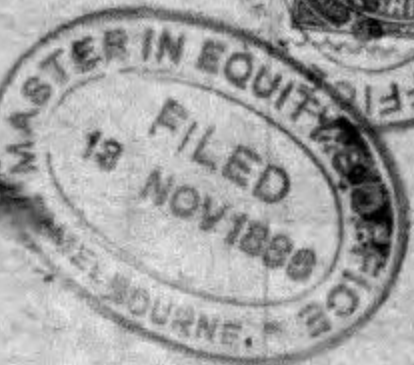

This is the last Will and Testament of me Peter Campbell presently residing at Parer Brothers' Hotel in Dourke Street East, Melbourne in the Colony of Victoria now a Public Lecturer, and formerly known as "The Australian Voluntary and Undenominational Bush and Gold Fields' Missionary". — After payment of all my just debts, funeral, and testamentary expenses, I Give, Devise, and bequeath Unto my Sister, Georgina Janet Campbell now or recently residing in Melville Place, Station Road, Dollar, (in Scotland), and whose former residence was at Number Forty North Castle Street, in the City of Edinburgh, Scotland, — All my real and personal estate, with the exception only of a sum of Fifty Pounds Sterling which I hereby Give, Devise and bequeath as a legacy to "the Childrens' Hospital" in Melbourne aforesaid; which legacy is to be paid by my Executor herein after named to the Secretary or Treasurer of said Hospital within six months after my death. — And I hereby Appoint "The Trustees Executors and Agency Company (Limited)" of Queen Street Melbourne, in the said Colony of Victoria, Australia Executor of this my Will. In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand, this Thirteenth day of May in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and Eighty Six.
