and by what means the said David Andrade

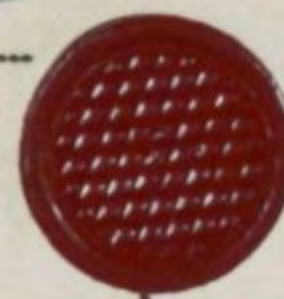
came by his death, I say that the said

VICTORIA TO WIT.

This Deponent,

*Patrick Shaw** Christian and Surname
(in full)on his oath saith, I am *Medical Superintendent*
residing at *The Hospital for the Insane, Ballarat*

The records of the Hospital for the Insane, Ballarat, show that the deceased David Andrade, whose body is now at the mortuary of the aforesaid hospital, was admitted to the aforesaid hospital on December 1st 1903 on the warrant now produced, and that he was then in good bodily health and suffered from delusional insanity. During the last 2 or 3 years he has been gradually failing and becoming weaker on account of old age. On 19.5.28 he was transferred to the hospital ward owing to weakness. On 22.5.28 he had an attack of syncope in the morning and was put to bed where he remained gradually failing until his death which, I have been informed, took place at 8.5 a.m. on 23.5.28. The cause of death was senility and heart disease.
