- 2 The said deceased died on the nineteenth day of
December one thousand eight hundred and ninety
five at Number 667 Canning Street Carlton
aforesaid. -
- 3 The said deceased left a Will bearing date the
seventeenth day of December one thousand
eight hundred and ninety four which is as
I believe the last Will and Testament of the said
deceased and which is unrevoked
- 4 By her said Will the testatrix appointed me
this deponent and James Morrison of
Cunningham Street South Yarra in the said
Colony Gentleman Executors thereof but he the
said James Morrison has renounced Probate
thereof and I verily believe he has signed or intends
to sign a Renunciation of Probate hereon. -
- 5 The paper writing hereunto annexed marked A
is the true last Will and Testament of the said

deceased and verily believe


- 6 The said Will was executed in the presence of George Reaby of Swanston Street Melbourne in the said Colony Post Importer and Samuel Bennett of Green Street Richmond in the said Colony Ironmonger's Assistant
- 7 The said deceased left no Real Estate in the Colony of Victoria but left Personal Estate in the said Colony not exceeding the value of Two hundred and ten pounds
- 8 That to the best of my knowledge information and belief the said deceased did not within the space of two years preceding the date of her death convey or otherwise dispose of for other than adequate valuable consideration any real or personal property of which she was seized or possessed.
- 9 That if I obtain Probate I will well and truly collect and administer according to law to the best of my knowledge and ability the property lands and hereditaments goods chattels and credits of the said deceased at the time of her death which at any time after shall come to the power or control hands or possession of me as her executor or of any other person or persons for me that I will make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the property lands and hereditaments goods chattels and credits of the said deceased which shall have come to the hands possession or knowledge of me or to the hands or possession of any other person or persons for me and the same so made will sign with my proper handwriting and will exhibit and deposit or cause to be exhibited and deposited the same inventory in

the office of the Master in Equity within three calendar months next ensuing the order granting Probate and further that I will make or cause to be made a true and just account of the administration of the estate which I have undertaken as to my receipts and disbursements and as to what portion is retained by me and what portion remains uncollected and the same so made will sign with my proper handwriting and will exhibit and deposit or cause to be exhibited and deposited the same account in the said office of the Master in Equity within fifteen calendar months next ensuing the order granting Probate. —
