duly sworn that she would well and truly collect

knowledge and ability the property lands and ~
hereditaments goods chattels and credits of the said
deceased at the time of his death which at any
time after should come to the power or control hands
or possession of her as his Executrix or of any other
person or persons for her and that she would make
or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory
of all and singular the property lands and ~
hereditaments goods chattels and credits of the
said deceased which should have come to her hands

possession or knowledge or to the hands or possession
of any other person or persons for her and the
same so made would sign with her proper
handwriting and deposit the same Inventory in
the office of the Master-in-Equity within three
calendar months next ensuing the Order granting
probate and that she would make or cause to be
made a true and just account of the administration
of the estate of the said deceased which she had
undertaken as to her receipts and disbursements and
as to what portion was retained by her and
what portion remained uncollected and the same
so made would sign with her proper handwriting
and exhibit and deposit or cause to be exhibited
the same account in the said office of Master in Equity within fifteen calendar months
and deposited, next ensuing the Order granting
probate. And that she believed he had no real
property and his personal property did not exceed

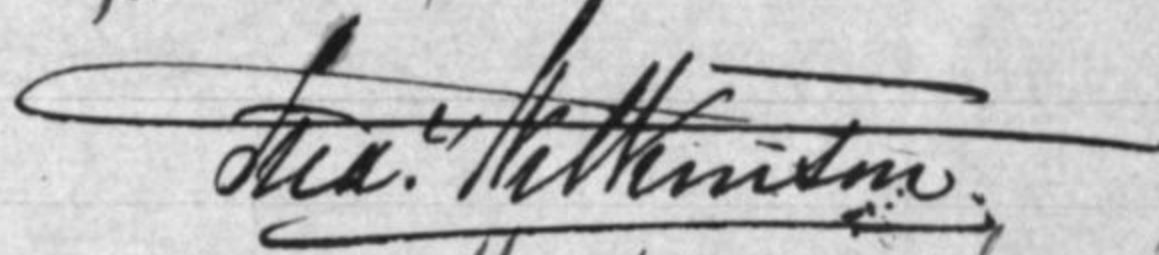
