John Druwam of Holmes Road Bendigo.

I appoint THE SANDHURST AND NORTHERN DISTRICT TRUSTEES, EXECUTORS AND AGENCY COMPANY LIMITED Executor and Trustee of this my Will and I declare that the said Company may execute any of the trusts or powers therein contained by its officers. I devise all my real estate and bequeath all my personal estate to the said Company upon trust after payment of all my just debts to funeral and testamentary expenses as follows

I direct my Executors to allow my wife Fanny Druwam to have the use of and reside in the dwelling erected on my residence area allotment situate at Holmes Road aforesaid together with the use of the furniture and effects therein and thereon as a home for her during her life. And as to all the rest and residue of my personal estate I bequeath the same unto my said Executor upon trust to sell call in and convert the same into money and invest the moneys arising therefrom upon such securities as trustees may lawfully invest and pay out of the income received therefrom the sum of Fifteen shillings per week to my said wife during her life. but should the income be insufficient for such purpose I empower my said Executor to apply so much of the capital sum as may be sufficient to make up the deficiency and upon the death of my said wife I direct my said Executors to sell and realize upon the said residence area and the said furniture and divide the proceeds of the realization thereof together with the capital and income of any of the aforesaid investments between my children namely John Thomas Druwam, William James Druwam, Richard Henry Druwam, Fanny Louisa Druwam, Francis Frederick Druwam, Agnes Druwam, Ernest Druwam, Helena Druwam and Alexander Druwam, or such of them as shall be living at the time of such distribution, in equal shares and proportions

And I hereby authorise the said Company to postpone for such period as shall seem expedient in the interests of my estate the sale calling in and conversion thereof.
