That the mark "x" which appears at the foot of the said Will is the proper mark of the said Richard Frembath and that the signatures "John Annear" and "Stephen Dorman" which also appear at the foot of the said Will are of the respective proper handwriting of the said John Annear and of myself this deponent the Attesting Witnesses thereof.

5. That the said Richard Frembath was unable in consequence of his illness and the weakness of body attendant thereon to sign his name but he was in my opinion in full possession of his mental faculties and perfectly capable of making his Will
