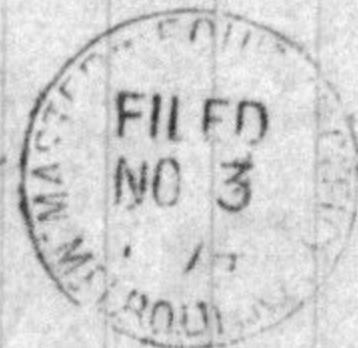

life on the seventh day of October in the year
of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
seventyfour

2 That he left a will which bears date the
second day of August in the year of Our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and seventyone
which will is as I believe unrevoked

3 That I believe the annexed parchment
writing to be the true last will and testament
of the said Henry Graham Nutt deceased

4 That by such will the said Henry Graham
Nutt appointed me this deponent sole executrix
of the same

5 That the said will was executed by the
said Henry Graham Nutt deceased in the
presence of Louis Shiuworth of One hundred
and sixtyseven Lonodale street working Jeweller

sum of One hundred and ten pounds sterling

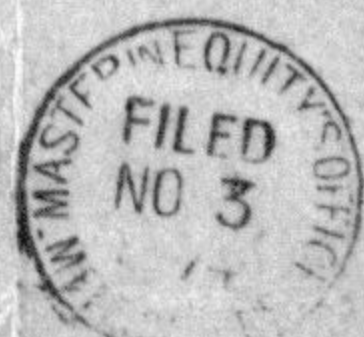

thereto I Give Devise and Bequeath all the real
and personal Estate of or to which I shall be entitled
at the time of my decease unto my dear Wife Sarah
Graham absolutely but as to estates vested in me upon Trust
or by way of mortgage subject to the equities affecting
the same respectively And I appoint my said Wife
Sarah Graham sole Executrix of this my Will hereby
revoking all other Testamentary writings by me at any time
heretofore made. In WITNESS whereof I have hereunder
set my hand this second day of August in the year of
Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy one.

Esq the Testator as his last Will and
Testament in the presence of us, who at
