and eighty five -

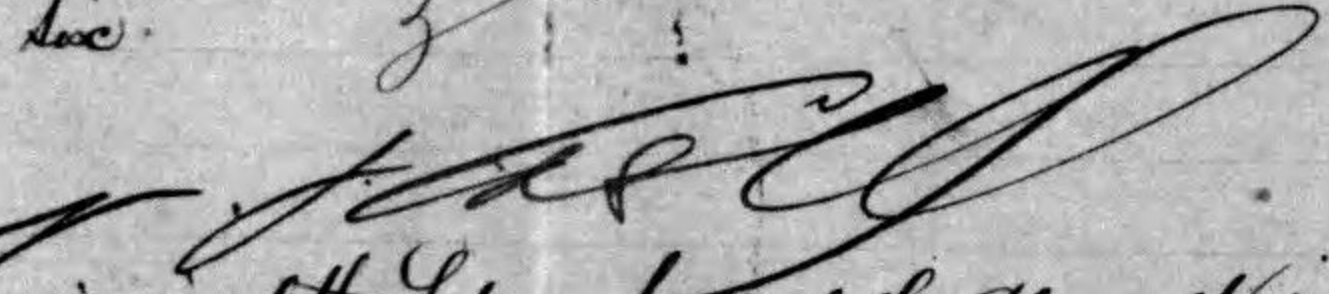
2- That the said Julius Henry Eller deceased made and has left a

in his own right but held some in his name but in fact as a
trustee and he had personal property in the said Colony not Exceeding in Value
Two hundred and forty pounds three shillings.
