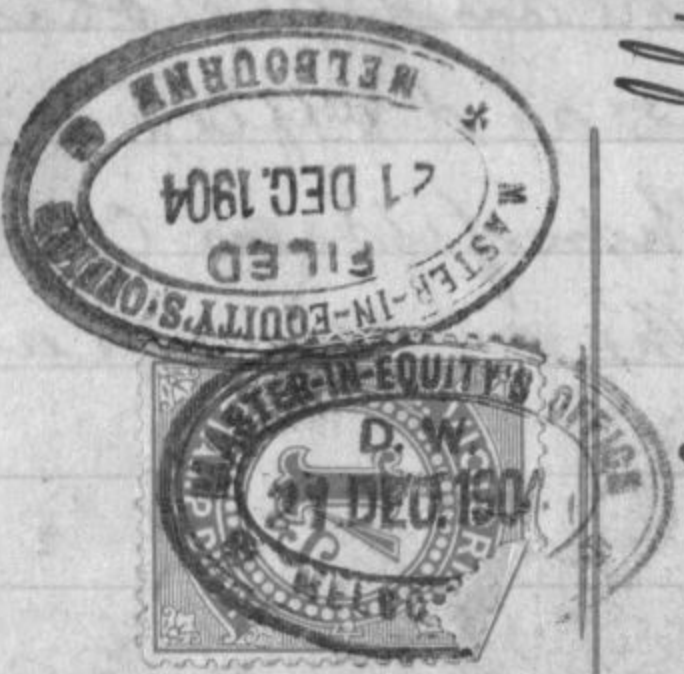

1. That I am seeking to obtain Probate of
the Will of the abovenamed Johann George
Luehmann deceased.
 2. That the said deceased died on the Eighteenth
day of November one thousand nine hundred
and four.
 3. That the said deceased left a will bearing
date the twenty ninth day of August one
thousand eight hundred and ninety two
which is as I believe unrevoked.
 4. That by his said will the said deceased
appointed me this deponent sole executrix
thereof.
 5. That I am the widow of the said Johann George
Luehmann deceased and my name is Maude
Isolene Isabel Luehmann but I am erroneously
called Maud Luehman in the said Will of
the said deceased.
 6. That the paper writing hereunto annexed
and marked with the letter "A" is the said
last Will and Testament of the said Johann
George Luehmann deceased.
 7. That the said deceased made and signed

his last Will and Testament in the presence of Boyle Robertson Tatey of Hillside Prince of Wales Park Northcote in the said State of Victoria Law Clerk and Charles French ~~of~~ formerly of Park Street South Yarra but now of 51 Railway Road Malvern in the State of Victoria Government Entomologist

8. That the said deceased left personal estate in the State of Victoria not exceeding in value the sum of three hundred and forty pounds but left no real estate in the said State.

9. That if I obtain Probate I will well and truly collect and administer according to law to the best of my knowledge and ability the property lands and hereditaments goods chattels and credits of the said deceased at the time of his death which at any time after shall come to the power or control hands or possession of me as his executrix or of any other person or persons for me: that I will make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the property lands and hereditaments goods chattels and credits of the said deceased which shall have come to the hands possession or knowledge of me or to the hands or possession of any other person or persons for me and the same so made will sign with my proper handwriting and will exhibit and deposit or cause to be exhibited and deposited the same inventory in the office of the Master in Equity within three calendar months next ensuing the order granting probate: and further that I will make or cause to be made

a true and just account of the administration of the estate which I have undertaken as to my receipts and disbursements and as to what portion is retained by me and what portion remains uncollected and the same so made will sign with my proper handwriting and will exhibit and deposit or cause to be exhibited and deposited the same account in the said office of the Master in Equity within fifteen calendar months next ensuing the order granting probate.

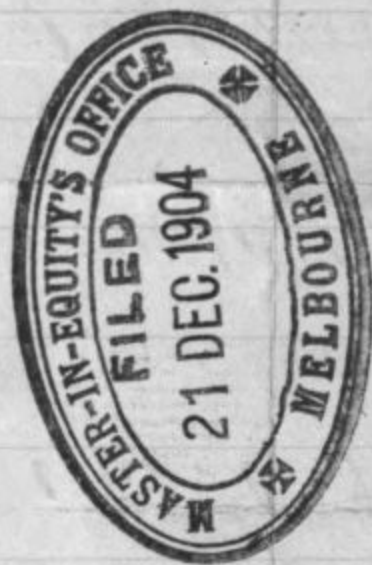
