- 1— That I am seeking to obtain Probate of the Will of the above
named Henry Johnson late of 238 Toorak Road South Yarra
in the Colony of Victoria Professor of Music deceased.
- 2— That the deceased died on the 10th day of June 1895 at 238
Toorak Road South Yarra aforesaid.
- 3— The said deceased left a Will dated the 25th day of August
1890 which Will I believe to be the last Will and Testament
of the said deceased and which is unrevoked.
- 4— By his said Will the said Testator appointed me this
deponent Executrix thereof.
- 5— The paper writing hereunto annexed marked "A" is the
true last Will and Testament of the said deceased as I
verily believe.
- 6— The said Will was executed in the presence of George
E. Clayton of 29 Murray Street Prahran Bank Clerk
and H. C. Woodhouse of 29 Murray Street Prahran Clerk.
- 7— The deceased left no real estate whatsoever in the Colony
of Victoria but personal property in the said Colony
not exceeding the value of £238-10-0
- 8— That to the best of my Knowledge information and
belief the said deceased did not within the space of
two years preceding the date of his death convey or otherwise
dispose of for other than adequate valuable consideration

any real or personal property of which he was seized or possessed

9- That if I obtain Probate I will well and truly collect and administer according to law to the best of my Knowledge and ability the property lands and hereditaments goods chattels and credits of the said deceased at the time of his death which at any time after shall come to the power or control hands or possession of me as his ~~my~~ executrix or of any other person or persons for me, that I will make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the property lands and hereditaments goods chattels and credits of the said ~~my~~ deceased which shall have come to the hands ~~my~~ possession or Knowledge of me or to the hands or possession of any other person or persons for me and the same so made will sign with my proper hand writing and will exhibit and deposit or cause to be exhibited and deposited the same inventory in the office of the Master in Equity within three calendar months next ensuing the Order granting Probate and further that I will make or cause to be made a true and just account of the administration of the estate which I have undertaken as to my receipts and disbursements and as to what portion is retained by me and what portion remains uncollected and the same so made will sign with my proper hand writing and will exhibit and deposit or cause to be exhibited and deposited the same account in the said office of the Master in Equity within fifteen ^{calendar} months next ensuing the order granting Probate.
