4. That the said deceased left no real estate in the State of Victoria and personal property in the said State not exceeding in value _____ to the best of my knowledge information and belief the sum of Ten pounds. _____

The said deceased left him surviving me this deponent his Widow Rachel Simpson of Christchurch New Zealand Widow Rosina Lezard of Christchurch aforesaid Married Woman Carrie Cutten of Temuka in New Zealand Married Woman ----- Elizabeth Levy and Isidore Schwartz residing somewhere in the United States of America who are his only surviving next of kin entitled by law to share in his property. The said deceased had not so far as I know communicated with his family for years so that I am unable in the case of the lastmentioned two to give more exact addresses. _____
6. That I am the Widow of the said deceased and as such I claim to be entitled to administration of his estate. _____

8. That to the best of my knowledge information and belief the said deceased did not within the space of two years preceding the date of his death convey or otherwise dispose of for other than adequate valuable consideration any real or personal property of which he was seized or possessed.

9. The said deceased carried on the business of a Piano Importer and Piano Dealer in conjunction with one Robert Clark at 312 Flinders Street Melbourne.
