



This is the Will marked "A" referred to in the annexed affidavit of Alvina Borschmann sworn before me at Beechworth in the State of Victoria this 17th day of March One thousand nine hundred and eleven.

This is the Last Will and Testament OF ME
Gottfried August Borschmann. Warder of Beechworth
in the Colony of Victoria

AFTER payment of all my just debts funeral and testamentary expenses
I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH unto my wife Alvina Borschmann
all my real and personal estate whatsoever and
and whosoever for her sole use and benefit during
the minority of any and all my children and upon
the youngest of my surviving children attaining
the age of twenty one years. I will and direct
that all my real and personal estate shall be
equally divided between my said wife Alvina and
my then surviving children. But should my
wife be first deceased then I direct upon her
death that all my estate whatsoever shall then
be divided equally between my children then living

AND I HEREBY APPOINT Hermann Borske Executor
and my wife Alvina Borschmann

EXECUTRIX of this my Will IN WITNESS whereof I have hereunto
set my hand this fifteenth day of June in the year
of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eighty four
