

1. That the instrument now produced to me and marked "A" is  
the Will of the above-named Giacomo Righetti deceased.
2. That the said Will was made by me and duly signed, according  
to law by the said deceased on the day in these dates viz the  
20<sup>th</sup> day of August 1886 in the presence of me this deponent who  
then resided at Porto Sully aforesaid and also in the presence of  
occupators and also resided at Melbourne aforesaid and also  
at the residence of the said Giacomo Righetti (then of Deep Creek  
Cape Phillip in the said Colony of Victoria) and also in the  
presence of the said Giacomo Righetti being present  
at the same time and also at his request in his presence and  
in the presence of such other persons as were named in  
the instrument the circumstances are as follows - On the said 20<sup>th</sup>  
day of August 1886 in answer to my request I attended the
