Gabb all my real and personal Estate whatsoever
and wheresoever situate To hold the same unto and
to the use of my said Wife Philippa Gabb her heirs
Executors administrators and assigns for ever and I
hereby appoint my said Wife sole Executrix of this my
Will and hereby revoking all former or other Wills by
me at any time made I hereby declare this to be
my last Will and Testament In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand this fifteenth day of
May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and seventy eight
Signed by the Testator John Gabb
as and for his last Will and
Testament in the presence of
us being present at the same
time who in his presence at
his Request and in the presence
of Each other have hereunto subscribed
our names as Witnesses
