Wilkinson late of Saint Helena the Colony of Victoria Gentleman
deceased intestate

I George Lindsay Skinner of Number ninety nine Collins Street
in the City of Melbourne Solicitor make oath and say

1. I am acting as proctor in this matter for Anne Jane Wilkinson
the widow of deceased (who is applying for Letters of administration
de bonis non and to whom Letters of administration were granted on
the twenty second day of December one thousand eight hundred and
sixty four. The assets were then stated as personalty under
six hundred pounds. Deceased died on the seventeenth
day of October one thousand eight hundred and sixty four and
was possessed of real estate consisting of allotment 3 Parish of
South Melbourne. This realty was subject to a mortgage to secure
two hundred and twenty pounds principal and interest
made by the deceased and which after his death became
vested in the said Ann Jane Wilkinson in her own right

2. By conveyance dated thirty first day of January one thousand eight
hundred and seventy eight he said Anne Jane Wilkinson as mortgagee
and Mr. William Henry Wilkinson the eldest son and heir at
law of the deceased William Augustus Wilkinson conveyed
the said property to Miss Mary Hastie for seven hundred
and fifty pounds whereof £ 322 = 16 = 0 was payable on
foot of the said mortgage

3 The said Mary Hastie some time ago applied to bring
the said land under the provisions of the Transfer of Land Statute and
the Examiner of Titles has required administration de bonis non
to the unadministered estate of the deceased to be obtained
and a consent given by the administrator inasmuch as
the deceased died on the 17th day of October 1864 There
is no other unadministered estate except the said realty -

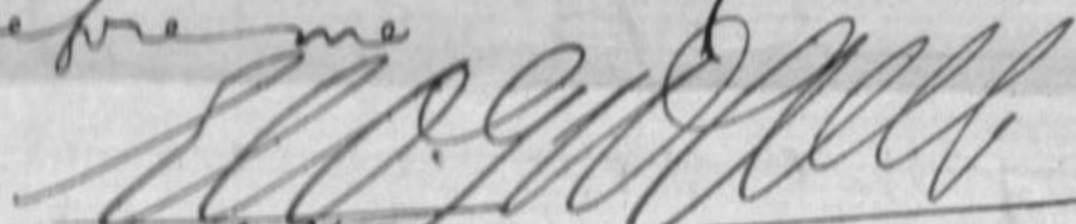
4. On the sixth day of February last an order was made
by Mr. Justice Molesworth that Letters of administration
de bonis non should be granted to the said Anne
Jane Wilkinson

5. A Bond in the sum of four hundred and eighty
pounds has been executed by her and the said Mary
Hastie as surety who has also sworn that she
is worth over and above all her debts the sum
of four thousand eight hundred pounds.

6. The said Anne Jane Wilkinson and I have tried
to procure a second surety but cannot do so.
