that we John Thomas Furniss of the River
Plenty in the District of Port Phillip in
the Colony of New South Wales Farmer
David Duncan of Parraville Cripps Land
in the District of Port Phillip aforesaid
Merchant William Casey of St Kilda in
the said district of Port Phillip Auctioneer
and William Francis Splatt of St Kilda
aforesaid Merchant

are and each of us is jointly and severally
bound unto our Sovereign Lady the Queen
her heirs and successors in the penal sum
of Seven hundred Pounds
to be paid to our said Sovereign Lady the
Queen her heirs or successors for which a
payment to be made we jointly bind
ourselves and our respective heirs executors
and administrators firmly by these presents
Sealed with our seals Dated this ninth
day of August in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and forty eight

The condition of this obligation is such that if
Harriet Wright Furniss wife of the above bounden
John Thomas Furniss and Anna Romana Duncan
wife of the above bounden David Duncan adminis-
tratrixes of all and singular the goods chattels credits
and effects of John Edward Cade deceased do make
or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of
all and singular the goods chattels credits and effects
of the said deceased which have or shall come to
the hands possession or knowledge of them the said
Harriet Wright Furniss and Anna Romana Duncan
or either of them or into the hands and possession
of any other person or persons for them and the same
so made do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the
Registry of the Supreme Court of New South Wales
for the District of Port Phillip at or before the

Tenth day of February next ensuing
And the same goods chattels credits and effects and
all other the goods chattels credits and effects of the said
deceased at the time of his death which at any time
after shall come to the hands or possession of the said
Harriet Wright Furniss and Anna Romana Duncan or
either of them or into the hands or possession of any other
person or persons for them do well and truly administer
according to law

And further do make or cause to be made a true
and just account of their said administration at or
before the ninth day of August 1819 and all
the rest and residue of the said goods chattels credits
and effects which shall be found remaining upon the
said administratrixes account the same being first
examined and allowed of by the Judge or Judges for
the time being of the said Court shall deliver and pay
unto such person or persons respectively as the said
Judge or Judges by his or their decree or sentence shall
limit and appoint

And if it shall hereafter appear that any last will
and Testament was made by the said deceased and
the executor or executors therein named do exhibit the
same into the said Court making request to have it
allowed and approved accordingly if the said Harriet
Wright Furniss and Anna Romana Duncan being
thereunto required do render and deliver the said Letters
of Administration (approbation of such Testament being
first had and made) in the said Court then this
obligation to be void and of none effect or else to
remain in full force and virtue
